Only lore and information relevant to these characters are in this document. Also, any unnamed characters, such as the members of Daegan's faction, Wolfgard, are not in the document as they're exclusively SFW characters.

Lore Context

Lore context that is only important to know for the characters

Anthros

This takes place where animals have evolved to take after now-extinct humans and are referred to as "anthros."



Harasa Kingdom

A hot desert village, with architecture primarily using round and boxy shapes, with a high level of poverty and crime (mainly theft). The Kingdom of Harasa neighbours the Kingdom of Elyda. The Kingdom of Elyda promises to help Harasa with poverty, but they don't lol idk - perhaps they had a war?



- People in the Kingdom of Elyda look down upon people of Harasa, seeing them as inferior for being unable to support themselves.
- There is high tension between them and there is a chance of a war breaking out across the story.
- They were initially one empire that eventually split into 2 due to the elitist albino species
- The social dynamics between the two deserts are also evident through how the scraps thrown away by Elyda onto the outskirts of Harasa, and many poor families wait for them to collect any scraps that possibly give them the slightest benefit
- They have the same religion as Elyda

Elyda Empire

A white desert home to rare albino desert species, who all migrated to this desert many years ago due to the rarity of their genetic condition. They were considered freaks, were outcasted and mistreated by the rest of Harasa. The monarchy and magic is a big part of the kingdom's culture, and they have strict rulers; it's heavily guarded and civilians are forbidden to leave - if they escape, they are never to return.

• Compared to the more boxy and round architecture of Harasa, Elyda's buildings are more triangular.





Alkas



In the snowy tundras of Alkas, the cold climate has rapidly been getting more and more harsh over the years, with blizzards and rates of death by hypothermia increasing. It is home to the wolves and other Alkasian species who are in tribes/packs led by chieftains. However its



population has been dropping, not only due to decreased survival rates, but also many have fled to other countries where they'll be able to survive.

- Daegan & Einar's homeland and where the OG Wolfgard was based before the pack dissolved.
- Idea: it's somewhere in North America (common wolf habitat)
 but it was renamed by furry civilisation (they don't know what a North America is), probably somewhere in Alaska

Alkas Conflicts

The old Wolfgard were ruthless barbarians who terrorised other factions, including Reginald & Cyrille's old faction, [unnamed Alkasian Deer Faction].

Albionia

Based off of the UK

- Pike's birthplace
- It's based on the ancient name for the British Isles, Albion

New Praxis

A cataclysmic disaster has wiped out the human race and the remnants of their modern culture have been left in ruins. Anthro civilisation has started to recover and rebuild what was left after the disaster in the cultural hotpot that is New Praxis.

 Techmire Syndicate, AMMOREIGN, Wolfgard & AquaHarvest are all based here.



Anti-Anthros

Non-sentient, alien-like creatures called anti-anthros take the role of lower-intelligence animals in this universe. Although some are small, docile and can be kept as pets, a lot of these anti-anthros are extremely powerful, ethereal and hostile beings that have lived for many years, and can be a danger to anthros.

Characters & Factions

Techmire Syndicate

Backstory: The last surviving humans - they eventually split due to their moral differences as some of the scientists want to capture anthros and test them as some of them are like really big and strong (like Daegan for instance) and they want to capture that essence of them to end furries as they're like fucking up the world or whatever due to their endless conflict, such as the conflict between Elyda and Harasa.

Techmire Syndicate are a research lab who secretly observe anthros to learn more about them so they can figure out how to take back their role as the dominant species. Anthros are also immune to a deadly disease and are also carriers of it, so they want to test on them to alter human DNA to be immune to it as well otherwise they can't regain their place in society as dominant species.

Project S.U.L. (Synthetic Ultimate Lifeform)

In order to help Techmire Syndicate reach their goal of humans becoming the dominant species again, they captured and tested on the anti-anthros to weaponize them against the anthro population. They essentially wanted to give them a form similar to an anthro, except much larger and stronger, to be able to eradicate and devour anthros,

and human-level intelligence for them to be obedient and be able to communicate with them. To achieve this certain form, a large, varied pool of anthro species (primarily lizards in Sulvy and Ivy's case as they were aiming to create a dragon-like form for them) were harvested to be used to create their anthropomorphised form. They named this project 'Project S.U.L. (Synthetic Ultimate Lifeform)'.



SODER™

SODER™ (SUL's Octane Driven Elixir Revitalizer™) is a carbonated soda-like serum with powerful uses. As well as having strength-enhancing and healing properties for SULs, it can power technology and weapons. SODER-powered weapons can only be wielded to the highest potential of its power by SULs, as they can control its SODER-induced powers. For example, Sulvy can activate his SODER-powered wings at will.

A big, boisterous, spoilt and possessive show-off. reckless and aloof of his surroundings despite his size. He often teases his own prototype and medic, Ivy, and frequently dismisses their concerns about him.

Has a superiority complex to **Ivy** and often teases them for essentially being a prototype. He has a shock collar controlled by the Syndicate which can disable him. its most often used on him when he drinks too much SODER™. His wings are powered by SODER™ which he also likes drinking so he just carries bottles of it on him all the time, it also has healing/stat boost properties depending on the flavour. He can activate and deactivate his synthetic wings, but if he runs out of SODER™ they cannot be reactivated. With enough SODER™, his circles markings on his tail and his claws glow,

becoming an indicator for when he is SODER™-enhanced and can breathe plasma energy.

He has a sort of rivalry with **Trei**, who believes he will be the one to put an end to Sulvy and Techmire Syndicate's reign of terror. The two have had many confrontations; unlike Trei who is serious and enraged during these situations, Sulvy is full of sarcasm and often gets cocky and demeaning towards him, as eliminating another anthro like Trei is just like eliminating any other anthro to him.

Backstory

A test subject victim of Techmire Syndicate, and former anti-anthro.

- Probably questions his existence and past as an anti-anthro
- Created from harvested anthros (primarily lizards to create his dragon-like form)

Sulvy, originally one of these powerful anti-anthros living for about 500 years, was captured and tested on by the human laboratory organisation. The organisation had already tested on 4 previous, less powerful anti-anthros, all unsuccessful in reaching ALL of their criteria of being intelligent, obedient AND powerful entities. Their fifth subject however, as they managed to find the most optimised anti-anthro species and combination of harvested anthro samples, accordingly named 'SUL-V', was successful, and was given the nickname 'Sulvy'.

As Sulvy was given sentience, he was instructed by Techmire Syndicate to obey their every order, and was also given a shock collar to keep him under control given his dangerous level of strength and power. The Syndicate also created a carbonated soda-like serum named 'SODER™ (SUL's Octane Driven Elixir Revitalizer) which had performance-enhancing and healing properties for Sulvy, as well as giving him the ability to convert it into plasma energy that he can breathe (or belch). SODER™ is also used to fuel Sulvy's synthetic wings. Sulvy is often berated by the Syndicate for drinking too much SODER™.

Trivia:

 Originally named 'SUL-V' as he was Techmire's 5th attempt at successfully creating the SUL.

- The barcode on his chest armour is his DNA barcode.
- His original form has a butterfly & heart-shape motif, but in his new form, he loses the butterfly motif to represent a loss of freedom. His fur pattern even resembles a caterpillar, suggesting that he regressed.
- Mainly inspired by popular early 2000s eastern media dragon designs (Legendz, Digimon, Pokemon, Bakugan, etc.)

- Genderless
- Ambiguous anthro race (former anti-anthro) resembles western dragon

Meek, nerdy & clumsy researcher & scientist who is often unaware of their own size. they hide their identity with a screen visor. They are often the victim of Sulvy's frequent teasing for being the inferior SUL prototype. Sulvy is also much more prioritised by Techmire Syndicate as their main weapon and most important organism that they have under their control. They is against the practises that of Syndicate and constantly berates Sulvy for willingly following the orders of the Syndicate by devouring anthros.

Backstory:

The 4th iteration of SUL, and the first one that successfully gained human-level intelligence. They were created the same way Sulvy was as they were also previously an anti-anthro. This failed to give SUL-IV the level of power and strength that they needed and was too intelligent and self-aware to blindly follow orders from the Syndicate. SUL-IV became sad: (cos they were neglected, and over time became jaded so they started to build off their intelligence to prove themself to the Syndicate. They also

nicknamed themself 'Ivy'. When Sulvy was created, they felt sympathy for him and wanted to protect him from the Syndicate, but also felt jealous. As a result, they are kept in captivity and used as a researcher at the lab, with the help of one of the human researchers which they grow close to as they are the only human that they fully trust.

- Theye remade the recipe for SODER™
 - The old version wasn't as effective and is why Trei's size and strength is closer to a regular anthro
- They are being kept in captivity so they don't go do anything reckless in anthro society that may expose the Syndicate. They also use him for his intelligence but it still goes underappreciated.

Ivy constantly ponders life outside of the facility, as their predecessor, the mysterious SUL-III nicknamed 'Thalathamon', managed to escape the Syndicate's facilities and their whereabouts are unknown. One of the tasks given by the Syndicate to Ivy was to research the possible whereabouts of Thalathamon.



 knight in AMMOREIGN, but it was Cyrille who convinced him that he saw Einar
 as a good person who genuinely wanted to move on from his past.

Fennel

Cyrille's cranky, snarky little stoat servant. He gets his arrogance from his high status of being the prince's servant and likes to boss everyone else around despite being a quarter of their size. As a result, no one really takes him seriously. He gets extremely annoyed at this as well as the crude and chaotic nature of many of the AMMOREIGN Order soldiers. However, Cyrille always knows how to humble Fennel whilst still retaining his elegant image, something that Fennel's arrogance and short-temper does not allow him to do.

AMMOREIGN Order

The military subdivision of the weapons vendor business, AMMOREIGN. **Eirik** is boss/leader of this unit, whilst **Einar** acts as the stand-in leader for the rest of the guys. They aim to protect civilians from **Techmire Syndicate**. Many of its agents are refugees from **Harasa** (Makarah, Hapi, Rashan, Barud &) and Elyda (Uraeus), and the others also come from former factions (Wolfgard, Techmire Syndicate).

- Generally follows a technical, militaristic soldier theme, with some royal/knight influence
 - There's some sort of thematic link between knights and modern soldiers/military since you could say they're like versions of each other from different eras of time.

A masked human knight hired by **Reginald** to be the leader of AMMOREIGN's military subdivision, AMMOREIGN Order. Only **Reginald**, **Cyrille** and **Einar** know he's a human. He is Einar's master and looks very intimidating; everyone in AMMOREIGN is scared of and respects him, especially considering that they don't know what he is under the mask. Despite this, he has a soft spot and fascination with anthros, and has a habit of petting the other AMMOREIGN members. This most often happens to Einar, which he gets annoyed with but he has to hide his frustration because he's his master. Eirik also has trouble hiding his adoration for anthros, breaking his intimidating image.

Backstory:

He used to be in the same group of last surviving humans that eventually became **Techmire Syndicate**, but he, along with a minority of the other humans, disagreed with the ethics of the Syndicate and they formed their own group. Eirik eventually went undercover, masking his identity as a human, to join AMMOREIGN. He reveals to Hartford his true identity, but due to his unique past experiences in the military, Hartford sees the value Eirik can offer to AMMOREIGN, and the military unit is formed with Eirik as the leader. Hartford agrees to keep Eirik's identity as a human secret.

Trivia:

- He is based off of a <u>Jotunn</u> from Norse mythology, which also further solidifies his similarities to Daegan
- He shares similarities to Einar's ex-master, Daegan
- He's a very big (considerably bigger than Einar, but no bigger than Trei) old, white-haired bearded guy under the mask

He has to put up with their antics a lot of the time, but Barud sometimes helps him out with this. He sees Daegan as a cruel leader, and strives to be a better leader than he was. His leadership style is more orderly and rational, promoting orderliness over savagery.

Backstory:

He feels extreme guilt for being part of the faction (Wolfgard) who terrorised Cyrille and his people back in Alkas. Cyrille however is a very forgiving person and doesn't feel any hostility towards Einar.

Trivia:

- The chains in his design represent how he feels chained to his past
- Knights came after vikings, the era the OG **Wolfgard** is heavily based off of. This shows how Einar believes he has progressed past the barbaric ways of Wolfgard.

Backstory:

Nicknamed 'Thalathamon', he was the first SUL to successfully attain human-level intelligence. However, he had a fairly average physique and power of a mustelid anthro of his size at the time (he used to be a lot smaller). This SUL is mysteriously missing from the Syndicate's labs (he escaped because he didn't want to kill anthros or be controlled). He became a wandering delinquent who keeps to himself and hides his face before he was taken in by Hartford at his weapon store as his apprentice. When this SUL escaped, they took some of the Syndicate's supplies with them, including weapons and a small SODER supply.

• He was created from harvested mustelid anthros

- The anthros that he was made from are primarily from AquaHarvest,
 Pike's company.
- Note: Trei's true identity as Thalathamon/SUL-III is a secret (lore moment)

Trei is an Ichneumon (Egyptian mythology), but to everyone else is an ambiguous mustelid guy (he just tells them that he is a mongoose). He is afraid that society won't accept him for what he is and it is very difficult to win over his trust as he often thinks that people just want him to reveal his identity.

Despite his sheer strength and power, he is a tinkerer at heart and is obsessed with weapon modifications and stuff. He often spends late nights seeing how weapons that he stole from the Syndicate works (and endlessly snacking on fast food), which was his main source of knowledge for creating and modifying weaponry himself. With this passion of his, he begged to become Hartford's apprentice if he taught him how to make/modify weapons. Hartford accepted him and essentially became his mentor and the only person he truly trusted. With his immense size and strength for the average anthro as well as his proficiency with using weapons, he also joined AMMOREIGN Order, AMMOREIGN's subsidiary military unit. As well as this, Trei handed over the stolen tech and SODER supply from Techmire Syndicate to AMMOREIGN for further examination and safekeeping.

- He thought of freeing SUL-I and SUL-II but wasn't able to, and now feels immense guilt.
- Hartford is the only one who knows Trei's secret of being an SUL. Hartford is fascinated by his existence and level of intelligence as a synthetically-created anthro.
- He has been working as an apprentice
- He still has the electric collar underneath his clothing, but was never able to remove it. To hide the fact he is an SUL, he modified the collar to look different, and also as a fashion statement! #slay
- Based on the <u>ichneumon</u> (Egyptian mongoose), the natural enemy of the dragon



Motive:

 Kill SUL-V (Sulvy) - as he lives amongst anthros, he wants to protect them from the Syndicate and prevent them from making more SULs like himself. He also doesn't like the idea that he is one of the prototypes and that Sulvy is the final, perfect form. He also doesn't like that Sulvy blindly follows the Syndicate's orders with his immense power.


Etymology:





Koen is the first anthropomorphised anti-anthro to be created by **AMMOREIGN** with their stolen SODER™ supply and **Trei's** DNA sample, giving him SUL-level power and stature, and is the newest member of **AMMOREIGN Order**.

He is one of AMMOREIGN Order's strongest soldiers alongside **Trei** due to their SUL-level powers and ability to use SODER to enhance their strength and abilities, and wield SODER-powered weapons.

Backstory:

Hartford started a project for AMMOREIGN where his goal was to create an 'SUL' of their own, without harvesting anthros, as they needed more manpower to fight back against **Techmire Syndicate**. He essentially used a sample of Trei's DNA and the SODER supply stolen by Trei on low-level anti-anthros to conduct this experiment.

After testing multiple iterations of the modified SODER formula on docile low-level anti-anthros, Hartford finally made the formula, nicknamed "SODER-K." The organism he created, nicknamed "K-10"

With this new power, he was able to join AMMOREIGN Order and become a frontline soldier alongside Trei.

Abilities:

- Like Sulvy, he has the ability to breathe (or belch) SODER energy, given he drinks enough SODER.
 - Koen has a seemingly endless thirst for SODER. However, due to AMMOREIGN's limited SODER supply, he often drinks regular soda when he's craving SODER to quench his unending thirst.

Personality:

He struggles to restrain himself from (quite literally) throwing his weight around some of the smaller AMMOREIGN members, often pinning Einar to the wall with his belly for fun, much to Einar's frustration.





Back in Alkas, she was a part of the old **Wolfgard** pack with her leader **Daegan**, and fellow pack member **Einar**. She grew to realise that she disagreed with Wolfgard's values and ethics; she wasn't treated equally and felt like an outcast for being one of the strongest female pack members, even rivalling their strongest men. The men in Wolfgard outcasted her as they saw her as a threat to their masculinity. This even escalated to violence and torture, leaving scars that would live with her for the rest of her life. On the other hand, the other women in the faction also outcasted her, although how they showcased these feelings were more subtle in comparison.

Whilst this was her main reason for eventually fleeing from Wolfgard, left to fend for herself in the increasingly harsh climate of Alkas, it took her even longer to realise the wrong in Wolfgard's savagery towards other innocent factions in Alkas, such as **[unnamed Alkasian Deer Faction]**. From then, she focused all of her vengeance and hatred towards Wolfgard. Wolfgard often caught sightings of her being able to live by herself, and they are surprised that she is even still alive. These sightings are often intentional on her part, as she wants to prove that she is better off without them.

Before everyone else in Alkas fleeing to escape its uninhabitable conditions, being completely alone allowed her to realise that she needed to leave and escape to New Praxis before the climate got even worse. Given her strength and combat skills, she became a mercenary.

Pike, a gay man, was his gay awakening, it takes time before he accepts the fact he is attracted to him as homosexuality was very taboo back in his hometown, Alkas.

Backstory:

His male descendants have had a record of being the alpha male in their pack, and when his dad grew too old, he passed down his position to Daegan. He and his pack live in the cold, snowy tundras of **Alkas** - he had to flee from his home with his pack but the climate became too harsh and he was the only one to survive due to his physique (thick) Other wolves have migrated from Alkas before (including **Einar**, one of Wolfgard's ex-members). Daegan believes that they are cowardly and should be shameful for not being able to cope with the climate any longer.

However, due to intense blizzards and other harsh climate conditions, it came to a point where they had no choice but to migrate. Daegan is stubborn, and forces his pack to endure it "like true wolves", otherwise they are cowards who can't endure the environment that they were born in. Some of them rebel and run away, and the ones that stay with him are too weak to stay alive for long. Now he is alone, he's trying his hardest to repress his guilt and shame - he failed to lead and protect his pack. In his mentally and physically weakened state, he migrates to New Praxis with the determination that he still has left and alcoholism be he is depressed lol.

He had a wife and son his wife fled along with the other pack members. He couldn't bare to see his own son surrender to the harsh climate, so he forced him to endure it until he died. This becomes a traumatic event for him and anything that remotely reminds him of it causes him to have an overreaction.

He had to form a new wolf pack except without wolves, which he is hesitant to do. Due to his wolven culture of packs having a clear social hierarchy, he is met with culture shock when his new team is opposed to the idea of being treated as inferiors even when Daegan is their leader. When he moved to New Praxis, he was alone, but found refuge with a group of fishermen called AquaHarvest. They provided him with food (fish, which he didnt like) and shelter. After becoming friends with the CEO, Pike, who is half skunk half bear, Daegan became more accepting of species from other nations, even if his past enemy faction had bears in them. Daegan also felt truly emasculated for the first time by Pike, as it was rare to see a man bigger and stronger than himself, which was a humbling experience for him.


