ABSTRAK: Anda dapat menulis manuskrip dalam Bahasa Indonesia atau Bahasa Inggris. ABSTRACT: Write your abstract here in Arial 11pt and single-spaced. The abstract should state the objective(s) or research problem(s), method, and results. You should not put any references in this section. The abstract should consist of 200-250 words.

Keywords: 3-5 keywords in English separated using a comma (,) and listed alphabetically.

INTRODUCTION

Write your manuscript in Arial 11pt except for the content of the table and figure. Write your manuscript on A4 size paper with margins: top 3 cm, bottom 3cm, right 3 cm and left 3 cm. Every paragraph in the manuscript should be single-spaced.

The introduction includes the background and objectives. In the introduction section, state the objectives of your work, provide an adequate background, and avoid a detailed literature survey or a summary of the results. Explicitly state the gap in the literature, which signifies the significance of your research. The introduction section ends with an emphasis on items to be discussed.

In your manuscript, you can cite the previous studies that inspire you by

mentioning the name of the author and the year of publication (Name of author, 2024). Please use APA 7th edition style. You are encouraged to use Mendeley as the referencing tool. It will help you insert your bibliography with ease. Manuscripts should be 5,000-7,000 words including references, notes, and tables.

LITERATURE REVIEW

Include the current knowledge including substantive findings, as well as theoretical and methodological contributions to your topic. A literature review surveys books, scholarly articles, and any other sources relevant to a particular issue, area of research, or theory, and by so doing, provides a description, summary, and critical evaluation of these works concerning the research problem being investigated.

Subtitle

When paraphrasing a source that is not your own, be sure to represent the author's information or opinions accurately and in your own words. Even when paraphrasing an author's work, you still must provide a citation to that work. When directly quoting an author's work, provide citation marks at the beginning till the end of the citation, and the page number is necessary to be noted beside the name of the author and year of publication.

METHOD

In this section, provide sufficient detail to allow your work to be reproduced. It includes participants, location (if necessary), instrument(s), data collection technique, and data analysis. You also need to elaborate on the source of data and their context. You must also provide a scientific reason for each part of your chosen research method. Methods already published should be indicated by a reference. Only relevant modifications should be described.

FINDINGS

The findings and discussion section may be separated or combined. In the findings section, present the results of your work. Use graphs and tables if appropriate, but also summarize your main findings in the text. If you separate the results and discussion sections, DO NOT discuss the results or speculate on why something happened. It goes in the discussion section.

When you want to insert a table, make sure that you also write the name of the table. The title size is 12 and the content size is 10. Number the tables subsequently throughout your article and the title is written above the table. Position the table appropriately, keeping it close to the text that addresses it. Make sure the entire table is on one page.

In writing table, note that the line is single-lined. All vertical lines are invisible, all horizontal table lines are invisible except those above and below column headings and the one at the bottom of the body of the table. The table heading at the top and the note at the bottom are part of the table (see Table 1 for example).

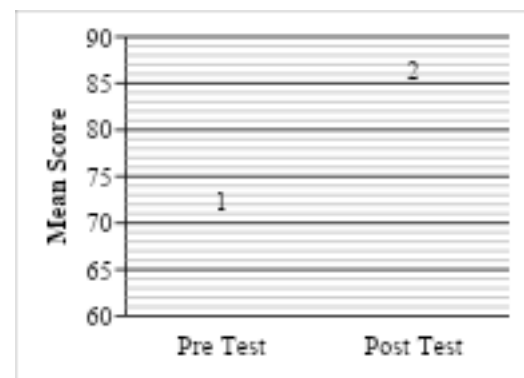


Figure 1. The comparison of results.

Everything that is not a table is labeled "Figure". Position the figure appropriately, keeping it close to the text that addresses it. The title size of the figure is 12 and the content size (if any) is 10. Number the figures subsequently throughout your article and the title is written below the figure in the center position (see Figure 1 for example).

DISCUSSION

In this section, highlight the most significant results, but do not repeat what has been written in the results section. The purpose of the discussion is to interpret and describe the significance of your findings in light of

what was already known about the research problem being investigated and to explain any new understanding or insights that emerged as a result of your study of the problem. A combined Results and Discussion section is often appropriate. Therefore, combining the results and discussion sections is also permitted. Please note that all citations mentioned in the text should be listed in the references section and versa versa.

CONCLUSION

Provide the conclusion to your study, and final words on the value of your analysis, research, or paper. Limitations of your study should be addressed. Recommendations for future research related to your topic should also be mentioned. You should not include any references in this section.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS (optional)

Give credit to funding bodies and departments that have been of help during the project, for instance by supporting it financially.

REFERENCES

It is strongly recommended that you cite high-quality references and from the latest publications. Citations and references should be written in APA 7th edition format. Sort the references alphabetically.

APPENDICES (optional)

If there is more than one appendix, they should be identified as Appendix A, Appendix B, etc. Formulate and equations in appendices should be given separate numbering: Eq. (A.1), Eq. (A.2), etc.; in a subsequent appendix, Eq. (B.1) and so on. Similarly for tables and figures: Table A.1; Fig. A.1, etc.
