Costume Details

Costume pickup: April & May.

We will be sending home costumes after class. You can hang your costume up at home if desired. Please keep all accessories like bows, hairpieces, etc. with your costume. Make sure to look at the accessories you'll need to complete your recital costume below!

Please arrive to the dress rehearsal and show in costume! You can wear a cover up over your clothes (such as a sweater or large t-shirt) if desired. Avoid eating in costume to keep it free of stains.

DO NOT WEAR YOUR COSTUME BEFORE DRESS REHEARSAL. Please save it for the show so that it's in the best possible condition! You can wear it as much as you like after the recital. Use it for dress up, costumes, or wear it just because it's awesome!

For wrinkled costumes, some easy ways to fix a wrinkly costume are to hang it in the bathroom during a shower or steam it with a hand steamer. Don't wash or iron your costume as it's easy to damage them!

Some of the costumes come with accessories. If you can't figure out one of the accessories, don't worry! Just bring it with you to the recital and ask a teacher or assistant for help putting it on!

If desired dancers can wear makeup for the show! A foundation, blush, and pink lipstick are recommended, perhaps complemented with a modest amount of eyeshadow and mascara. Opt for shades that are somewhat richer than your regular makeup to ensure your features stand out.

- Hair down but pulled out of the face

Boys

- Costume Includes: One piece shirt and overalls, Bandana.

 - Ballet or Jazz Shoes: Tan or skin tone (dancer's preference)

- Hair pinned/slicked out of the face
- Bandana tied around neck as shown

Recital Day Checklist

For Dancers:

	Costumes: Ensure all costumes are neatly packed and organized, including
	any accessories such as hats, gloves, or props.
	Dance Shoes: Pack all necessary dance shoes for each routine, including ballet
	slippers, tap shoes, jazz shoes, etc.
	Hair Accessories: Bring hair ties, bobby pins, hairnets, and any other
	accessories needed to style hair according to the recital guidelines.
	Makeup Kit: Include basic makeup essentials such as foundation, blush, eyeshadow, mascara, and lipstick or lip gloss for touch-ups.
	Hair Products: Bring hairspray, hair gel, and hairbrushes or combs to keep hair
	in place throughout the performance.
	Water Bottle: Stay hydrated by bringing a reusable water bottle to sip on
	backstage.
	Snacks: Pack low-mess snacks such to keep energy levels up during rehearsals
	and downtime.
	Costume Cover Ups: It can be nice to bring some clothes for over your
	costume and a change of clothes for after the show. This way your dancer can
	stay comfortable before and after performances.
	Dance Bag: Use a spacious bag to keep all items organized and easily
_	accessible backstage.
	Personal Items: Don't forget essentials like extra tights, safety pins, band-aids,
	and any medications needed during the event.
	Activities: The nature of a recital is that dancers will have waiting time and
	downtime. Keep your dancer busy backstage with their favorite activities.
	Some great ideas are coloring (pencils and crayons only, NO MARKERS), screens, quiet games and puzzles, or a favorite book. You know your dancer
	best! Bring what works for them!

For Fa	amilies:
	Camera/Smartphone: Capture memories by bringing a camera or smartphone
	to take photos or videos before and after performances. Don't forget to tag us!
	Encouragement: Bring positive energy and encouragement to support the
	dancers backstage and cheer them on during their performances.
	Patience: Be prepared for potential delays or last-minute changes and
	approach the event with patience and flexibility.

Backstage Etiquette for Dancers:

We know our dancers have unique needs and may not be able to follow every etiquette rule, however we ask that every family do their best to follow and help their dancer follow this etiquette. This will make the recital a wonderful experience for everyone!

Respectful Behavior: Maintain respectful behavior towards fellow dancers, instructors, and volunteers backstage.

Quiet Atmosphere: Keep noise levels to a minimum backstage to avoid distracting performers and disrupting rehearsals or performances.

Stay in Designated Areas: Remain in designated backstage areas and avoid wandering into restricted or off-limits areas without permission.

Support Each Other: Offer words of encouragement and support to fellow dancers before and after their performances.

Respect Costumes and Props: Handle costumes and props with care to prevent damage or misplacement. Avoid playing with or touching items that do not belong to you.

Follow Instructions: Listen carefully to instructions from instructors or backstage organizers and follow any guidelines or protocols they provide.

Timeliness: Arrive on time for dress rehearsals and performances to ensure smooth transitions and avoid delaying the schedule.

Be Prepared: Bring all necessary items such as costumes, dance shoes, makeup, and hair accessories to avoid last-minute rushes or forgotten items.

Clean Up After Yourself: Dispose of trash properly and clean up any messes or debris backstage to maintain a tidy environment for everyone.

Audience Etiquette for Spectators:

Arrive on Time: Arrive early or on time for the recital to avoid disrupting the performance or distracting performers and fellow audience members.

Silence Electronic Devices: Turn off or silence cell phones, pagers, and other electronic devices to prevent interruptions during the recital.

Remain Seated: Stay seated during performances and avoid getting up or moving around unless absolutely necessary.

Avoid Talking: Refrain from talking or whispering during performances to allow everyone to focus on the dancers and enjoy the show without distractions.

No Flash Photography: Turn off your flash to ensure you do not distract the dancers while they perform. Don't forget to tag us on social media @adeptdance!

Applause at Appropriate Times: Applaud and show appreciation for performers at the end of each routine or act, but avoid clapping or cheering during the actual performances.

Keep Children Engaged: Help children understand the importance of quiet and respectful behavior during the recital, and encourage them to watch and enjoy the performances.

Respect Seating Arrangements: Follow designated seating arrangements and avoid saving seats or blocking the view of others.

Exit Quietly: If you need to leave the auditorium during the recital, do so quietly and discreetly to minimize disruptions for performers and audience members.

Express Appreciation: Show appreciation for the hard work and dedication of the performers by offering applause and positive feedback at the end of the recital.
