



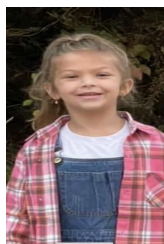

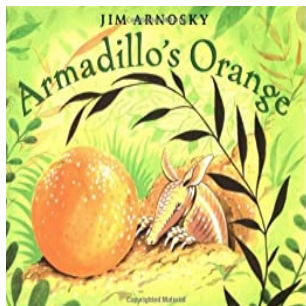
Animal Habitats

we will read "Skunkdog" and make a skunk craft to go along with the letter Ss.

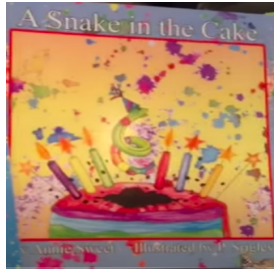
