BEWARE!!! SCAM ALERT

One of our residents just received a telephone call stating that they failed to show up for jury duty and that there was a warrant for their arrest. The resident was advised to not hang up the line and to have no third parties involved. They were then advised to go to the store to get prepaid cards. THIS IS A SCAM. No one will ever call you to advise that they have a warrant for your arrest, the Sheriff's Office would just show up at your door. No law enforcement agency will

ever ask you for money over the phone. If there is ever any question please call security.

OUR ROADS...Did you know?

The roads in River Hills are private roadways, 100% funded and maintained by the Community. However, we are also a participating member in the South Carolina UART (Uniform Act Regulating Traffic) program since July 20, 1976. We have coordinated with York County Sheriff Kevin Tolson who has signed off on the speed limits and traffic signs for the River Hills community and the paperwork has been filed with the York County Registrar of Deeds.

UART attaches South Carolina state laws to the roadways within the community. It allows your Security officers run blue lights and enforce only state laws, no County ordinances, within the community for the safety of all, which is the intent of the UART program. This also allows Security to enforce laws and issue citations to those who choose to speed, tailgate in the back gate, run through the gate arm and cause damage, those who attempt to enter through the front traveling on the wrong side of the road, etc.

While UART is a valuable tool that the community has to ensure safety and security of the community, we would much rather have voluntary compliance by those traveling within the River Hills community, ensuring everyone's safety.
