### SIDE EVENT GUIDELINES AND REGISTRATION FORM

The CAADP PP is an annual partnership event that brings together key stakeholders to assess progress made in the implementation of the CAADP commitments. The PP provides an opportunity for sharing and learning among stakeholders. For this year 2022, the 18<sup>th</sup> CAADP PP deliberations will be conducted around the recommendations and policy implications of the third Biennial Review (BR) Report that was endorsed during the 35<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session of the Assembly of the African Union Heads of State and Government held in February 2022, and subsequently launched on 10 March 2022. The call to action was centred on the need for member states to accelerate implementation of the Malabo Declaration Commitments, *Ending Hunger by 2025* being one of the seven commitments that directly relate to improving food and nutrition security.

The theme of this year's CAADP PP is ***"Nutrition Sensitive Agriculture: A pathway to strengthening resilience of agro-food systems on the continent."***

This call is to invite you to propose side events during the CAADP PP, to allow engagements with all and among stakeholders, especially those that contribute to the CAADP Malabo Agenda. At side events, technical partners are able to share experiences, lessons learning, best practices and innovative perspectives (which may be derived from case studies) to contribute to efforts that should address challenges observed from the seven Malabo commitments and strengthen partnerships.

Please note that, in accordance with the CAADP PP programme, the side events may be organized in a hybrid format at the margins of the 18<sup>th</sup> CAADP PP.

Please use the following guidelines to propose the side event

- ✓ Side Events must be relevant to the African Union Theme for 2022 and align to the Theme of the CAADP PP.
- ✓ Side Events should speak to the Implementation of the CAADP Commitments, with possible emphasize on the recommendations pertained in the Third BR Report.
- ✓ are submitted by AU Members States and organizations supporting and intend to share experiences, showcase achievements, and/or present new initiatives aimed to support the CAADP Malabo Commitments.
- ✓ After the Side Event, Organizers are requested to prepare a summary of the outcomes and send it to the Organizing Committee members.

The Side Event Organizer will be notified once approval has been granted by the CAADP PP Organizing Committee.
