College Board Opportunity Scholarships- The College Board Opportunity Scholarships program guides you through the college planning process and offers you a chance to earn money for college for each action you complete. The more effort you put in, the more opportunities you'll have to earn. It doesn't require an essay or an application, and it doesn't have a minimum GPA or test score requirement. Scholarships can be used at 2-and 4-year colleges. Half of all scholarships are reserved for students with an annual income below \$60,000.

2022 IEC Memorial Scholarships-Illinois Electric Cooperatives will award 14 scholarships in 2022 to financially assist students in the electric cooperative family. The 14 scholarships, \$2000 each, will be awarded through the Thomas H. Moore Electric Cooperatives (IEC) Memorial Scholarship Program.

Eight scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors who are sons or daughters of an Illinois electric co-op member. A ninth scholarship, the Earl W. Struck Memorial Scholarship, will be awarded to a student who is the son or daughter of an Illinois electric cooperative employee or director. Four additional scholarships are reserved for high school seniors enrolling full time at a two-year Illinois community college who are sons or daughters of Illinois electric cooperative members, employees or directors.

The 14th scholarship, the LaVern and Nola McEntire Lineworker's Scholarship, will help pay for costs to attend lineworker school conducted by the Association of Illinois Electric Cooperatives in conjunction with Lincoln Land Community College, Springfield, IL. Sons and daughters of co-op members, relatives of co-op employees or directors, and individuals who have served or are serving in the armed forces or National Guard are all eligible for this scholarship.
