Accessibility Checker is an automated accessibility scanning tool to help your WordPress website become and stay accessible. Dynamically scan, monitor and report on the accessibility status of your website in real-time as content, themes, and plugins are updated.

Evaluation Methods Used:

Testing the Accessibility Checker WordPress plugin involved extensive use of leading assistive technology, such as screen readers and screen magnifiers, as well exclusive use of the keyboard. Specific screen readers used include VoiceOver in

Chrome on Mac and NVDA in Firefox on windows. In addition to testing by accessibility professionals the product has been tested by multiple blind and low-vision individuals.
