So far we have moved from my living room to Mary St. Centre, to Canadore College, to online and Zoom for the pandemic, to my studio and porch, and then to the Fairgrounds. Each spot has taught us something, let us grow in a certain way. Which way will it be important for us to grow in our new location? What can we do better in terms of location?
- 3. This is, of course, the most important question: would you be willing to help out with a search committee? How should the search committee go about finding a piece of land? Should we lease, purchase or rent? Can we offer this committee some guidance? Concrete suggestions? What funding is available to us? Where do we turn next?
