For example a hoodie with a zipper, is much easier for a child to learn to put on and take off by themselves than a pullover sweater or one with buttons. If the clothing is too difficult, your child will always be dependent on an adult to get dressed. You do not need to replace what you have. This is for when you are getting new clothes and you are able to make choices.
