Practice Centers Substantial Portion of the Day - Full Day = cumulative total of 140 minutes in centers / Half Day = cumulative total about 60 minutes	 Center names are based on Frog Street language (see p.3 below). Between 3 and 6 centers will offer suggested activities that reinforce content. Teacher introduces suggested activities (this is distinct from completely open-ended free play). Small groups occur during Practice Centers time. Cognitive ToyBox, games or observations, may occur during Practice Centers time. 	Page 18

Gross Motor ~ 2 x 30 minutes	 Outdoors or indoors Refer to teacher guides for suggested activities. Should be planned for daily. Should NOT always be an unstructured free-for-all. Staff should spread out to monitor and avoid being on devices. 	Page 19
Quiet Time ~ 60 minutes	For full day - children don't have to sleep but should be quiet and on cots	
Closing Circle ~ 10 minutes	 Check on Commitments Notice Kind Acts Reflect on Learning 	Page 32

Gross Motor	Outside Area/Outdoors
Math	Toys and Games or Manipulatives
Construction also called Makerspace	Block Area
Science	Discovery
