The New Teacher Support Office is accepting Support Provider applications for the 2020-2021 school year. Support Providers serve a critical role in the trajectory of a new teacher's success in education.

Thank you for your interest in participating as a Support Provider for new teachers enrolled in the SCUSD Induction Program.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must have three or more years of effective teaching experience
 - Years as an intern, substitute, or holding a STPS do not apply towards years of experience
- Hold a clear credential
- Must have a recommendation from their current administrator/supervisor
- Previous training in coaching and mentoring is preferred

Induction Support Providers:

- will support the Participating Teacher in the development of the Individualized Learning Plan (ILP)
- will provide Just-In-Time support
- will attend one Onboarding Workshop prior to beginning the program
- use Google Classroom and google drive for the collaboration and completion of the completed support activities required for the Participating Teachers
- will complete a support activity google form for weekly support activities on a weekly basis (providing on average one hour of support weekly
- will attend and participate in a Winter Seminar (mid-year)
- will attend and participate in a Colloquium (end of year)
- will participate in quarterly Peer Review process with a Peer Review Partner
- will complete program surveys as requested
- will adhere to the Support Provider roles and responsibilities

Applying to be a Support Provider does not ensure a Participating Teacher will be assigned with you next school year. It simply lets the New Teacher Support know you are interested in participating when needs arise.

If you are currently assigned a participating teacher(s) who are planning on returning in 20-21, our intent is to keep the current SP/PT assignments as they are, pending any changes for either the support provider and/or the participating teacher.

Compensation: Support Providers receive a stipend of \$526.19 quarterly upon completion of the assigned program duties for the first assigned participating teacher and receive a \$394.75 stipend quarterly for additional participating teachers assigned to them upon the completion of the assigned duties.

Support Providers MUST attend one Support Provider On-boarding Workshop (each year) to be assigned participating teachers. Assigned through Google Classroom virtually.

To receive an invitation to the Support Provider On-boarding Workshop we must receive your Support Provider Application.
