

Bell to Bell, No Cell

Bell to Bell BB NO CELL

Beginning this school year, all Arkansas public schools will follow Act 122- Bell to Bell, No Cell

This law prohibits student use of cell phones and personal electronic devices from the start of the school day until the final bell—including during lunch and class transitions. This change comes from the Arkansas Legislature and will be implemented statewide.

- 1st Offense- Student turns their phone into the office and receives lunch detention. Parents are notified of consequences if student violates policy again.
- 2nd Offense Students will receive one (1) day of Saturday School.
- 3rd Offense 3 days of out-of-school suspension (OSS)
 - 4th Offense 5 Days of OSS
 - 5th Offense 10 Days of OSS
 - 6th Offense -

DRESS CODE REMINDERS



Acceptable Attire (Do's)

- Students must wear shoes at all times
- Shirts or blouses must include cap sleeves
- Skirts, dresses, and/shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length



Unacceptable Attire (Don'ts)

- Pajama pants
- Sleeveless shirts
- Shirts that expose the midriff
- Pants with holes, rips, or tears above fingertip lengh
- Hats, caps, hoods, or bandanas
- Clothing or accessories that display obscenities, violence, or references to illegal substances
- Pants that sag or reveal undergarments
- Trench coats

REMINDER: DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

Students are reminded to adhere to the school dress code at all times. Please note the following guidelines:

- Shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length when arms are extended at your sides. <u>Track shorts are not permitted.</u>
