**WARWICK SHOW TIMELINE** - 10/4/2025: This is a different kind of Cavalcade show known as an "MFA Affiliate" show. That means it follows the MFA model. MFA stands for "[Music for All](#)" better known as BOA ([Bands of America](#)). Bands of America is a competitive circuit, much like Cavalcade, but on the national level. Some of the best high school bands in America compete in the BOA circuit.

**The show starts at NOON** (luckily we are the last group to go on at 4PM so we don't need to have a super early call time... though it is still earlier than normal.) Bands ARE NOT SORTED BY GROUP SIZE. All bands compete against each other and they are ranked in order no matter what the size of the band is. After we perform and scores for "prelims" are announced. The top 8 bands will be asked to perform their show AGAIN at "Finals." That means we might get to perform the show twice. We need to work really hard in the next two weeks to see if we can break into the top 8 and have the chance to perform a second time. Even if we don't end up being in the top eight, that's okay! We will still get to stay to watch the top 8 groups perform and then head home.
