

Hello it's Seamus! Long time no chat for two of you, first time chat for one of you. I would like to start off by congratulating the final two for playing a great game, AJ and Mega you two truly deserve to be here. Jackson i would congratulate you but you have a very VERY slim chance at receiving my vote tonight and ill explain why going forward.

So coming into this game i knew only 3 people, Jake who I played a game with a few months earlier but truly didnt speak to after, Jose who i met once and didnt like and thought was a catfish, and Ally who i never had spoke to just knew who she was. So everything i know about you people came from what i was told and what you told me. Now if you know about my resume from Tumblr like AJ does, you would know not only have I been around for awhile but i can play a decent game. Y'all killed me very early and congrats to you, but i still have lots of opinions.

So i will start with Jackson, then go onto mega, and save AJ for last. Let's begin.

Jackson, i say you are least likely to get my vote for numerous reasons, if you can explain and answer my questions well i will vote for you even if i don't really like you. I am gonna name a point then have questions attached. So survivor is a social experiment. And your social game was actual shit. Prove me wrong, name me 1 move or thing u did without hals or loris or anyone else knowing that improved ur standing in this game. My final point, i came into this game with basically 0 experience with anyone here, whereas you and your friends not only all got cast, but all chose to work together to vote off people like me who had no idea. I find it hard to praise someone whose game relied 100% on previous relationships and friendships. Even if you were not that close to someone in ur group chat, you still knew them and actively went out of ur way to ensure only u all would be left. I dont think that is something praise worthy. You still have a great shot at winning because lord knows your friends wouldnt vote someone outside of your friend group, but odds are unless you can truly explain this you wont be receiving my vote.

then at the end i will have some questions. If you think you can try and argue or refute what i said in the non question portion you will have 0% chance of receiving my vote. So at first i thought you were super nice but also really annoying. I have 0 idea how old you are but if i had to guess i would say 14/15. You were pretty much silent besides when waiting for results and you almost never started the strategy convos it was always me. Now seeing how you were just waiting to swap with your friends i guess you were just trying to make urself not a target so you could get there?? Not something i respect. I don't respect people who just want to work with their friends, it defeats the purpose of a game, and overall puts a negative lense on a game for people who are just trying a new platform (such as myself with this game). SO here is my first question. 1. Yes or no only i do not want to see anything else, do you believe if you were in my position in this game, where you knew no one coming in, do you think you would be in the position you are in right now? (if you answer anything besides "yes." or "no." you will automatically not receive my vote). My second question 2: Yes or no only, do you regret playing with your friend group and relying on them?

Now let's move onto my next part of my kritik of you. Your RoP was fine, thanks for not making it shit, there were some inconsistencies between what you said in your RoP for me, your opening statement of my round, and what you pmed me. So next time you try and lie make sure the people cannot connect the fucking dots because my momma didn't raise an idiot and i think yours didn't either. SO what is the truth Mega, you claim you didn't want me to leave, and I said i was fine voting anyone as long as it saved me, and you pretty much went blank and wouldn't say anyone. Isn't that how survivor works? You get the people who you **KNOW** don't want you in the game out first?

I love this. It is really true. I had control of MYSELF and pushing ME forward. I also didn't vote in the minority except for FDP and Ally.. once Ally left the game I had **more** control over my game and what I was going to do. And what I was going to do was anything I could to get myself to this point.

I appreciate your speech Seamus and I had a lot of fun playing with you. I hope my response was what you were looking for and I look forward to seeing you at the finale!

FFSierraDamnThomas's Response:

Seamus, I'd like to say that with all due respect, we were only together for one vote of the merge (and during that one vote, WE TARGETED each other) at the end of the day, I wasn't going to invest that much time into a personal relationship with you, and you **KNOW** that. What country am I studying in for this year? Why did I choose to do so? Are these questions that I could reasonably expect you to answer if we talked with each other for a combined total of twenty minutes (WITHOUT other people on the jury telling you)? I think you of all people should understand why I may not have fully gotten to know you as a person. That being said, I think you're 20 (or 19?), you moved to London, and I think you decided to play EMVV because one of

the hosts recommended it to you on a tumblr ORG (believe it was Ginga). To address one of your other points, of course I'll have talked to you less than most of the jury, they were all, for the most part, on Unangan 2.0 with you and had more than a few tense days to speak with you. Even with that time, Scott wanted to target you because of the lack of communication between the two of you - I probably learnt more about you than he did, regardless of whether or not it was through direct conversation with you or other players before meeting you at the merge. I was open to working with you, but at the end of the day, the former Unangans had the numbers advantage, and if working with Scott to vote you as he wanted was the easiest path to dismantling that, I was more than happy to oblige (I would also like to mention that I didn't know Scott prior to the start of the season, but I had heard of him being in SBBB, another ORG).

You imply that I am more at fault for having known many others prior to the start of the season, but I really only knew Mega and Hals well prior to starting (I know it's easy to then criticize me for having one them be my ideal endgame after F7 [and the other maybe being ideal as someone easy to cut at F3], but they were my best options for getting the job done at that point). On my starting tribe, I had never talked with Elmo or Loris beforehand, I arguably had a meta-target on my back from Luke (who I had blindsided multiple times in previous EM games prior to the start of the season), and I had played one EM game with Marry. You and AJ were given each other, and FDP was her friend prior to being cast to her own admittance. While Mega didn't have meta-connections on his starting tribe either, he was also in a demonstrably worse position than I was on his tribe pre-swap (my positioning in which I could argue was also a move I made without Hals or Loris, but I know that isn't what you want). I'll reiterate again, I didn't want you, Ally, or AJ specifically at the merge, but that was what the flipper wanted to do, and as a result everyone on Taku 2.0 was obligated to vote you to try and gain some control. I explained in my statement why I was comfortable with my name being thrown out - for the early merge, I had an idol in my pocket, and I wished to keep the semblance of unity by not having to throw out names and reveal where I stood in terms of my relationships within the alliance. But at the end of the day, even Tobi and Hals would have to agree that it I got unlucky in that my best relationship game-wise was also the one that they knew was in the same timezone as I was, and from the same starting tribe and thus more likely to be connected. Hals (and Tobi I guess from Hals telling him unless he knew our meta-connection from having known each other well beforehand, in which case, it just adds fuel to the fire) knew that Mega and I were likely to be close because of our meta-relationship: there was nothing in game suggesting that we were close other than that, including the fact that I had to stay up to 1 am my time just to talk with him, Hals, and Tobi on any substantial basis (which wore me the FUCK down over the course of nearly a month. I think you can empathize deeply with me on this point LOL). One may use this as another opportunity to criticize me for having to "rely" on that connection to further myself in the game, but to both the credit of Mega and myself, we were always willing to turn on each other if it made sense (it simply wouldn't have been a move worth making until F4, in which it may make sense for us to bubble the other and be taken to F2 auto against nearly any pair of players F7 on bar Loris. [and in the premerge taking out Unangans was pretty much the only good move by the four Unangans so we needed each other then as well]). When you say that I sought to protect the people in my group anyway, well, I really don't have a counter for that,

because the people who were “in the group” were all people I swapped with and/or flipped to our side. AJ and Ally were the last to do so and were thus my biggest targets for the next vote. I argue that the votes were mostly tribe dominated and not circlejerk dominated like you suggest; we wanted to vote the people out on the other side that posed the biggest threats to our games, and after you it was one of AJ/Anna, and then one of JB/Elmo (both of whom were in the Sammy chat, and no, I didn’t know Elmo was in it prior to the start of the season, or even in season up till like I wanna say F17? But it’s not like I had some sudden revelation and was like “Holy fuck, HE’S in the sammy chat? Gotta protect him even more now”. I also mostly lurk in the chat anyways so that’s why there might be a bit of confusion as to who I did and didn’t know prior to the start of the season).

Even within my swap tribe, there were plenty of disconnects between players (myself and Tobi [which I will defend in my answer to Tobi’s question], Mega and loris, hals and loris, etc.) that I feel made the season more dynamic than what you suggest - I feel that there was room for players in the minority to maneuver around the social dynamics, and they did. Elmo and AJ took note of the fact that Tobi was going to be the easiest person to get me or Mega to vote off in favor of saving Elmo, for example (but I argue that AJ could have placed herself in a better position through having closer relationships with Scott/Loris, people who were demonstrably on the bottom of the alliance. They didn’t feel that AJ was useful to their game, so of course they weren’t going to reach out to her).

You act as if there was no leeway for AJ whatsoever in her social game due to the circlejerk, but other members in the jury have been clear that they were the ones that had to approach her to ever initiate conversations on strategy/create a better bond, etc. I find it hard to believe that AJ can claim she had that she had when several of the mid-jurors didn’t speak to her; if she had actively been reaching out to them, then you’d have an extremely valid point with how the game was inherently going to screw her over no matter what. But the fact of the matter is that that never happened, and that can’t be claimed.

My biggest move was positioning myself such that no matter who past F8 had power, I had a good shot at making endgame no matter what. In Mega’s mind I’m his best (and easiest) shot at winning, I’m a vote for Tobi and Hals/their best shot at winning endgame comps from our side of the vote (with an idol to protect myself if they try to make a move against me; not that they would have until F5 anyway), and I provide the same secondary function as Hals/Tobi to AJ and Elmo. Obviously in addition to that I was loris’ F2. I had the option of flipping at 6 or 5 on Tobi and Hals respectively depending on how I felt about their physical games/likelihood of screwing over my endgame through moves of their own (at F5, it would have likely been either Elmo and AJ voting Hals and Mega and Hals voting Elmo, or Hals tries to get them to do me and actually attempts to flip, in which case I just use my idol and get Hals out. In the first scenario, I still get Hals out because it creates a F4 where I have a much better shot at getting to F2 [Elmo and Mega I think are more likely to target each other here rather than myself if AJ wins immunity again; it’s better than the alternative of Mega and Hals likely voting against me at F4, with AJ maybe taking my side and sending me to firemaking, but that was a maybe at best]). If it’s a F2

and I make a move against Hals at 5, I have a really good chance at making F2 regardless of who wins the endgame comps, but she was removed, so I never had the chance to claim that that was a move that I did.

To end, thank you for asking me these questions/giving me a lot of material to work with regarding your opinion of my game; you had the option to ignore me altogether due to our limited time spent together, but you went a different route, and I respect that.

MegaRaptor789's Response:
