As we move forward with our distance learning, our daily math virtual learning options will look a bit different! These changes will help to better mirror our daily classroom times, provide more flexibility for families, and ensure that district expectations are being met.

<u>Traditional, In Person, Class Times</u>	<u>Distance Learning Schedule</u>
30 minutes whole group instruction	30 minutes virtual online lesson (10:00 am on weekdays)
30 minutes independent practice and small group instruction	15 minutes pre-recorded video on the same topic as whole group lesson for additional practice/support
15 minutes debriefing and exit ticket	30 minutes independent practice - Google Classroom practice activity, Khan/Education Galaxy/Prodigy
TOTAL: 75 minutes of math instruction and practice	

SO, each day of distance learning will comprise of the following:

- 30 minute live virtual lesson through Google Meet with Moon - 10:00 am ONLY
- 15-20 minute pre-recorded, posted video on Google classroom to provide additional practice/support on topic of day
- 30 minutes independent practice
 - Google Classroom practice activity (5 questions per day, self-checking)
 - Additional choice practice activity
 - Choices providing individualized instruction based on progress - Education Galaxy, Khan Academy, Prodigy

- 3) Please note - if you are on a phone or a tablet, you will need to download the apps "Google Classroom", "Google Meet", and "Google Forms". All are FREE.
