*****Standard Classroom** configuration typically consists of a ceiling-mounted projector and a retractable, motorized projection screen used to display the installed networked PC computer (with built-in DVD drive and front USB ports), or the installed document camera. As well, a laptop computer or portable video device may be displayed by connecting to the local input panel at the lectern. The room's audio system may include a lectern-mounted gooseneck microphone, wireless lapel microphone, and handheld microphone(s).
