

## RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRANSPLANT TEAM MEMBERS

| Sl No | Department                     | Designated Personnel | Qualification | Responsibilities  |
|-------|--------------------------------|----------------------|---------------|---|
| 1     | Transplant Program Lead        |                      |               | As coordinators they are responsible for successfully running the transplant program as per the International Practice Guidelines.  |
| 2     | Transplant Coordinator         |                      |               | Ensure complete patient coordination with regards to medical and legal aspects of transplantation.  |
| 3     | Medical Team                   |                      |               | Coordinate in hospital transplant services, care of organ donors both pre and post-transplant. Ensures multidisciplinary team care plan for all recipients and living donors in the pre, intra and post-transplant period.                                  |
| 4     | Nursing                        |                      |               | Ensure adequate care of recipient and living donors throughout the transplantation process and infection prevention and control.  |
| 5     | Physiotherapy                  |                      |               | Provide physiotherapy care and work closely with transplant surgeons in continuum from to post-transplant period for rehabilitation of patients.  |
| 6     | Nutrition                      |                      |               | Monitor nutrition status of patients by ensuring nutrition intake and educating patients in the pre, intra and post-transplant patients to facilitate adequate healing.   |
| 7     | Pharmacologist                 |                      |               | To ensure appropriateness review of drugs for transplant patients admitted in the hospital.   |
| 8     | Psychologist and Social Worker |                      |               | Coordinate organ transplantation of all organ recipient and donor, provide comprehensive social work services including patient education, counseling and emotional support to transplant patients and their families through all phases of transplantation |
| 9     | Living Donor advocate          |                      |               | Ensure support to living donors so that their rights are protected in accordance with medical ethics and in a culturally appropriate manner   |
| 10    | Anesthetists                   |                      |               | To ensure complete care of recipients and living donors with respect to anesthesia and pain management through the pre, intra and post op care  |

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| 11 | OT Manager               |  |  | To ensure OT availability.<br>To ensure that the required staff and resources shall be made available.                 |
| 12 | Infectious diseases      |  |  | To ensure that in infection control practices are being followed appropriately.  |
| 13 | Radio diagnosis          |  |  | To ensure adequate radiology service support through the pre, intra, post op care of both recipients and living donors |
| 14 | Critical Care            |  |  | To provide ICU and critical care support in the post op period   |
| 15 | Administrative oversight |  |  | To ensure all licensures, law and regulations are being followed as per the local law.                                 |
