The booking process

- Where did you find out about the spaces
- How they went about booking
- Method of booking
- What information were you asked to provide
- How long the process took

- What went well
- Any frustrations
- Ideas for improvement

Using the room

If booking successful:

- Next steps after booking
 - Booking confirmation
 - Information provided prior to going to venue
- Experience at the venue
- Experience of the room
 - Facilities - Wifi, kitchen, etc
- Whether they have used the service since

If booking is unsuccessful:

- What went wrong
- What did they do instead
 - Avenues
 - Any frustrations
