

Unlocated Houses in the Crownlands

This document will list the unlocated houses in the Crownlands and where they should be built, as well as any information we know and speculation about the size and importance of each house. For now, all information is gathered from AWOIAF, but each build will need further canon evidence, if any. For each build, I will write the basic “known” information and then my reasoning for its size and location under “Speculation.”

Blount

Known: Noble (porcupines on green) Ser Boros Blount - knight of the kingsguard

Speculation: Medium-small, near woods because of porcupines

Bywater

Known: Noble (silver fish on blue) Jacelyn Bywater - officer of the city watch (Mud Gate), from a lesser branch

Speculation: Medium-large, with a smaller holdfast of Bywaters, near ocean because of fish.

Chelsted

Known: Noble (crossed spike and mace), Qarlton Chelsted, hand of king for Aerys II.

Speculation: Medium-large since he was chosen as the hand (most are from major houses), nearer Kingslanding

Chyttering

Known: Noble (yellow and gold), Lucos Chyttering, remained loyal to Stannis after Blackwater

Speculation: Medium, probably near coast, because he supported Stannis.

Cressey

Known: Noble (coins and helmets on blue)

Speculation: Medium, nowhere in particular! Filled out the middle.

Edgerton

Known: Noble (wheel of flame on indigo)

Speculation: Near a major road because of the wheel and near the border, as are most Edgertons. Since our Kingsroad is crowded, I placed it near the border of the Kingswood on an important intersection.

Farring

Known: Noble (knights on purple and white), remains loyal to Stannis, serves in Storms End

Speculation: Near the coast or Stormlands, placed behind the Blackwater marshes, perhaps they have some access through the rivers and thought Stannis would win!

Follard

Known: Noble (fool's cap on white and red) Dick Follard (on the wall), Ser Follard, a Queen's Man converted to worshipping R'hllor

Speculation: Near enough to the sea, placed as lord of Briarwhite.

Gaunt

Known: Noble (Three lances, black and pink) Ser Gwayne, murdered in Defiance of Duskendale, avenged by Ser Barristan Selmy

Speculation: Near Duskendale, centrally located

Harte

Known: Noble (Red harts on white and blue), Elwood Harte, loyal to Joffrey

Speculation: Near Antlers, closer to woods.

Langward

Known: Noble (Crown of stars, burgundy on black)

Speculation: Means "tall guardian" and has a crown, which could mean a lighthouse guarding the spires of the Merlin king.

Mallery

Known: Noble (Six Mullets on Purple) Lothar Mallery died at Mummer's Ford

Speculation: General

Pyle

Known: Noble (Greathelm on white)

Speculation: asdf

Rambton

Known: Noble (Ram's Head on Yellow), sworn to Sunglass, sons died on Dragonstone

Speculation: On Massey's Hook

Rollingford

Known: Noble (Six rondel fountains on grey)

Speculation: asdf

Thorne

Known: Noble (Flail on red and black) Alliser Thorne (Night's Watch) Rickard Thorne (former kingsguard)

Speculation: asdf
