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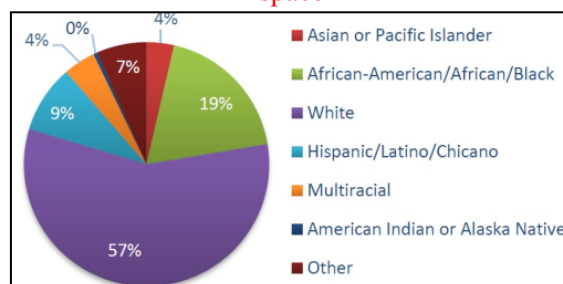


Figure 1: Demographic of respondents (font: Times New Roman, size:9pt)
