

# 2026 Educational Game Design Award

## (EGDA) Consent Form

Event Name: "2026 Educational Game Design Award" (hereinafter referred to as "the Award")

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### I. Participation Requirements & Intellectual Property

1. **Acceptance of Terms:** Upon completion of registration, all team members are deemed to have accepted the Award regulations, schedule, notices, rules, scoring criteria, awards, and this Consent Form as announced by the Organizer. Should there be any violation or unexcused absence, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel their eligibility for participation or award.
2. **Eligibility Guarantee:** Participants guarantee that they meet the eligibility requirements, have the right to participate in this Award, and that their participation does not violate any regulations, contracts, or laws.
3. **Originality and Plagiarism:** The submitted work must be original, and must not copy, imitate, or plagiarize the work of others, nor infringe upon any intellectual property rights, copyrights, or other rights of any third party. Citations must clearly indicate the source to avoid violating intellectual property laws. In case of any violation or evidence of plagiarism, the Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the team from participation or winning, and the participant shall bear all legal liabilities and related compensation.
4. **Content Standards:** The themes, plots, and educational objectives of the submitted works must align with positive social values generally recognized by the public. Content involving gore, excessive violence, pornography, drugs, discrimination (including but not limited to gender, race, and religion), or any material that violates laws, public order, and good morals, or promotes negative social behavior, is strictly prohibited.
5. **Final Review Authority:** The Organizer reserves the right of final review over the educational significance of the submitted works. If the values conveyed by a submission are significantly inconsistent with the purpose of this competition (promoting educational significance), the Organizer has the right to disqualify the entry or exclude it from selection, and participants shall not raise any objections.
6. **Non-Commercial Status:** The submitted entry must not have been sold commercially in any form prior to the competition. If a work is found to have been sold, the Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the entry and forfeit the registration fee.
7. **Copyright Ownership:** Participants retain full intellectual property rights to their work.
8. **Promotion Rights:** Participants agree that the Organizer and Executive Unit may use the entries, in whole or in part, for promotional purposes, including media publication, public display,

distribution, public transmission, and public broadcasting.

Participants understand and agree that no further compensation or fees will be sought for the aforementioned uses, and participants agree not to exercise their copyrights (including economic rights and moral rights) or any other rights against the Organizer, the Executive Unit, or their licensees.

9. **Indemnification:** Should the Organizer or Executive Unit use the submitted work for relevant promotional materials, and a third party raises a claim of infringement or other rights against the Organizer or Executive Unit, the participant shall be responsible for handling the matter and shall be liable for all damages incurred by the Organizer and Executive Unit as a result.
10. **Promotion Use of Personal Image:** For the purpose of documenting related activities, the Organizer and Executive Unit may take photos or request participants to provide related photos and dynamic images. Team members agree to the use, editing, printing, display, promotion, or public disclosure of their personal likeness, name, and voice without compensation, for the purpose of final reporting or promotion.
11. **Online Promotion:** Participants agree that the Organizer and Executive Unit may utilize the submitted work through the internet, storage media, or other means (including but not limited to website/webpage publication, presentation of related records and photos, public transmission, public presentation, public broadcast, screening, display, or providing access) for various promotional activities related to this Award.

## **II. Competition Procedures & Responsibilities**

1. **Information Accuracy:** To avoid any impact on rights and interests due to inability to contact, all participants of the team must provide accurate personal and team information. The team representative must obtain the consent of all team members to provide their personal data to the Organizer and Executive Unit.
2. **Judging Respect:** Participants must respect the final decisions of the judging panel.
3. **Award Vacancy:** If the entries in a specific category do not meet the required standards after evaluation by the judging panel, the Organizer reserves the right to leave the award for that category vacant.
4. **Third-party Conduct:** Participants understand that if any third party unauthorizedly reproduces, edits, modifies, distributes, or publicly transmits the submitted work after it is published or utilized in accordance with this Consent Form, the Organizer and Executive Unit shall not be responsible.
5. **Non-Return Policy:** Participants agree that the Organizer and Executive Unit may dispose of the submitted documents and materials and are not obligated or responsible for returning them.
6. **No Rights Acquisition:** Participants agree that participation in this Award does not grant them any intellectual property rights or other rights of the Organizer, Executive Unit, or any third party.

### **III. Awards & Recognition**

- 1. Prize Acceptance Details:** Winning teams are required to sign for and receive their prize money and items at the award ceremony. The attribution of the prize money income and the name on the withholding certificate will be determined by the participant, and the prize money will be paid to the designated winner upon signing at the ceremony.
- 2. Promotional Obligations:** Winning and shortlisted teams are required to cooperate with promotional activities organized by the Organizer. CraCrat.INC holds the first-release publishing rights for outstanding works.
- 3. Tax Compliance:** Winners must comply with the Republic of China (Taiwan) tax laws for income tax, complete relevant forms, and provide proof of identity and a personal bank account number to claim the prize. Failure to comply will be considered a forfeiture of the award qualification.
- 4. Internal Disputes and Penalty:** Any disputes regarding the internal division of labor or distribution of rights and interests within a team (such as the receipt and distribution of prize money) must be resolved by the team members themselves; the Organizer and Executive Unit will not intervene. Participants shall not transfer the rights and obligations of this Award without the written consent of the Organizer, Executive Unit, and other team members. Participants who register must comply with all regulations herein. The Organizer and Executive Unit reserve the right to disqualify the participant and reclaim any prize money or awards already granted, and to make such a decision public, if any term herein is violated. The participating or winning team shall be liable for any damages caused to the Organizer and Executive Unit as a result of such violations.

### **IV. General Terms and Conditions**

- 1. Information Guarantee:** Participants guarantee that all information provided is true and accurate, without any fabrication, falsehood, or deception.
- 2. Minor Participant Consent:** If the participant is a minor, they guarantee that they have obtained the consent of their legal guardian to participate in this Award.
- 3. Forfeiture of Rights:** Participants agree to immediately and unconditionally forfeit their right to participate if they violate any of the activity regulations or rules listed in this Consent Form.
- 4. Final Discretion:** Participants agree that the Organizer and Executive Unit shall have the final discretion in case of any unaddressed matters or disputes.
- 5. Non-Refundable:** Once registration is completed, participants may not request a refund.
- 6. Event Changes:** The Organizer reserves the right to modify or terminate the event at any time. Any changes or detailed notices will be announced on the official website without individual notice.
- 7. Right to Modify and Supplement:** In the event of force majeure or if there are any unaddressed matters, the Organizer and Executive Unit

reserve the right to modify and supplement the relevant content and regulations (including any changes, updates, or modifications to the event), in addition to compliance with relevant legal provisions, and such changes will be based on the announcement on the official website.

**V. Personal Data Protection Act Notification and Statement of Collection, Processing, and Use**

- 1. Data Management:** Personal data related to this Award is co-managed by the Network Learning Research Center of National Taiwan Science and Technology University and CraCrat.INC. The Organizer will collect, process, and utilize the personal data provided by participants for the "2026 Educational Game Design Award" in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act.
- 2. Purpose of Use:** Data is used strictly for competition management, including identity verification, communication, prize distribution, tax reporting, and contact for related marketing activities (Specific Purpose Codes 040, 090, 148).
- 3. Participant Rights:** Participants have the right to request access to, correction, deletion, or restriction of their personal data. Participants shall be responsible for any impact on their eligibility to participate, win, or receive prizes resulting from the exercise of these rights.
- 4. Mandatory Provision:** By registering, all participants are deemed to have read and fully agreed to comply with all regulations of this Award. If any member of the team does not agree to the aforementioned processing and utilization of their personal data, the participating team will be unable to participate in this Award.

## **Personal Data Protection Act Notification and Statement of Collection, Processing, and Use**

The operation and management of this Award are handled by the Organizer, the Network Learning Research Center of National Taiwan Science and Technology University and CraCrat.INC. The personal data provided by participants for the "2026 Educational Game Design Award" will be collected, processed, and utilized by the Organizer in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act of the Republic of China (Taiwan).

### **I. Matters for Notification**

- **Organizer and Executive Unit:** Network Learning Research Center of National Taiwan Science and Technology University, CraCrat.INC.
- **Purpose of Collection:** Archiving, storage, and editing of personal data for the duration of the Award, contact for marketing activities, and administrative operations related to the competition (Specific Purpose Codes 040, 090, 148).
- **Categories of Personal Data:** C001 - Personal identifiers, being the data provided during registration (e.g., name, date of birth, school name, department, grade, address, telephone number, fax number, email, etc.).
- **Period of Utilization:** The duration of the Award, until the payment of prize money is completed after the Award ends, and the period required for the Executive Unit to file income tax reports.
- **Area of Utilization:** Limited to Taiwan, Kinmen, Penghu, Matsu, or other regions outside of Taiwan.
- **Recipients and Methods of Utilization:**
  - **Recipients:** The Organizer and Executive Unit of this Award.
  - **Methods:**
    1. Used for prize collection and personal income tax reporting.
    2. Announcement of winners' names (and/or related personal data) on the official website, press conferences, and award ceremonies.
    3. Provided for news media coverage.
    4. Provided to logistics providers for contact regarding product delivery.

### **II. Participant Rights (In accordance with Article 3 of the Personal Data Protection Act):**

Participants in this Award may exercise the following rights regarding their personal data: (1) Inquire about or request access to the data; (2) Request a copy of the data; (3) Request to supplement or correct the data; (4) Request to stop the collection, processing, or utilization of the data; (5) Request the deletion of the data.

### **III. Agreement and Warning**

**By completing the personal data and submitting it in any way to the designated unit of this Award, the participant is deemed to have agreed to the collection, processing, and utilization of their personal data by the Organizer and Executive Unit. Participants may choose whether or not to provide personal data; however, failure to provide or incorrect provision will prevent participation in the event and the related services. The Organizer and Executive Unit will establish appropriate security maintenance mechanisms in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act to protect the participants' personal data security.**

### **IV. Mandatory Consent**

- **All participating team members have thoroughly read the above statement and understand the matters related to the collection, processing, utilization, and transfer of personal data for this Award.**
- **All participating team members agree that the Organizer and Executive Unit of this Award may collect, process, utilize, and transfer their personal data collected for this Award in the aforementioned manner, within and outside of Taiwan.**
