- SMNS charges school fees of \$100/student.
- Sugar Maple Nature School does not participate in the National School Lunch Program and does not provide lunch for students.
- Transportation is also not provided by Sugar Maple Nature School.
- Families at Sugar Maple Nature School must provide Oakisuits for their students in 5K-1st grade, and raingear for all students in 2nd-8th grade. Families must provide appropriate winter gear for all enrolled students, including waterproof boots, gloves, and snowpants. Water shoes, such as Keens, are necessary to participate in river programs for students in 3rd-8th grade. Oakisuits may be rented from the school for \$40 per school year.
- Sugar Maple Nature School follows a 4-day in-person schedule, with students attending on-campus classes from Monday through Thursday. On Fridays, the school provides a blend of synchronous and asynchronous virtual instruction to support continued learning.
