### HOW TO CLEAN YOUR CHROMEBOOK

The best way to keep your Chromebook clean and germ free is to have clean hands to begin with. Please **wash your hands or use hand sanitizer** before using your Chromebook. Keep food and liquids away from the device.

#### **CLEANING THE KEYBOARD**

- 1. Shut down the Chromebook (power off, don't just put the device to sleep).
- 2. Use one of the following to clean the top of the keys. **Be sure that whatever you use is not dripping wet.** If it is, wring it out BEFORE using it otherwise damage can be done to the electronics.
  - a disinfectant wipe
  - a cotton swab (dip in rubbing alcohol, dab the swab on a clean paper towel to absorb excess moisture, and smash the head of the cotton swab so it will fit better on the keys)
  - a Mr. Clean sponge dipped in rubbing alcohol
- 3. Allow the disinfectant to dry. Do not wipe it off.

NOTE: **BE VERY careful not to get any liquid into the Chromebook** or you could cause damage. If the wipe/swab or sponge becomes soiled, stop and replace with a clean one.

#### **CLEANING THE DISPLAY**

# Do not use alcohol or any other cleaner on screens or displays!

- 1. For general cleaning, get a soft, lint-free cloth. Use it to wipe the dust off the screen.
- 2. Dampen a sponge or lint-free cloth with water. Be sure to wring out all the excess moisture, then gently wipe the screen.
- 3. Let the screen dry completely before closing the lid!
