HOMEWORK

Homework is updated on Google Classroom under the "Classwork" tab daily, written on the classroom whiteboard daily, and verbally announced in class.

HOMEWORK GRADES

All homework/practice activities are graded as follows:

 $\frac{4}{3}$ - fully completed with great effort $\frac{2}{3}$ - partially completed $\frac{1}{3}$ - incomplete

O - did not complete/did not turn in/no effort demonstrated

Homework must always be completed <u>on your own</u>. Parents, siblings, friends are welcome to review with you; however, you are showing what <u>you</u> are able to do. If you are absent, it is your responsibility to check Google Classroom and the <u>CLASSWORK tab</u> to see what you missed.

LATE WORK

1 day late-students can receive 50% of the total earned points- only work where answers have not been provided. (online activities such as EdPuzzle, Quizizz, and Señor Wooly, etc. will not be awarded points after they have closed).

Homework practice will not be accepted after 1 day late. Work can be turned in for feedback only. Projects/assessments will be lowered by 10% each day late.

USE OF TRANSLATORS

When you use a translator (Google Translate/spanishdict.com, etc.) a few things happen:

- #1- you do not give yourself an opportunity to figure out how to say something
- #2- you do not necessarily know all of the words/grammatical structures it gives you
- #3- many times what you want to say/read is lost in translation

If you use a translator (obvious when the work is at too high of a level or does not convey meaning), it will be considered cheating. You will earn a zero on that portion of the assignment.

** IS IT EVER OK TO USE A TRANSLATOR?**

If you have tried your best to figure it out and you think you know what a word/phrase means, but you want to double check.

You will participate in a number of quizzes, tests, and other forms of assessments throughout the year. Your grade will be figured as total points throughout the quarter.
