— TESTING PROCEDURE —

RESEARCH QUESTION:

SCP-127 is a sentient anomaly which has an unique sense of intelligence as it displays situational awareness. As such, does SCP-127 retain memories of individuals who have previously bonded with it, even if they change their uniforms and are reintroduced with two other individuals? If so, this will determine how SCP-127 perceives individual's through their memory.

HYPOTHESIS:

I believe that SCP-127 has the capabilities of being able to withhold information through memories since SCP-127 is a highly intelligent entity that possesses motor functions which allow it to interact with others effectively. Being able to retain memories of past individuals who have formed a bond with SCP-127 allows it to remember them for the future which ultimately benefit SCP-127 as the connection can be maintained between an individual and itself.

The results from the test will assist in determining if SCP-127 is able to utilise its memories in scenarios which could provide an useful insight into understanding SCP-127's intelligence.

METHOD

TESTING PROCEDURES:

Before

Before entering the containment chamber of SCP-127, I will make sure that the actor is online and ready. Once we had entered the briefing room I'll be told to brief, as such

The brief is as follows -

"You are to follow my given instructions during this test.

One of you is to enter SCP-127's containment chamber and attempt to bond with it, whilst the other two remain outside. You are to refer to SCP-127 as "Gunther". Once inside, you are to dance and have a positive conversation with SCP-127, by complimenting it.

Once I deem that a bond has been formed, you will be escorted outside of the testing chamber and will equip an FP uniform, then all three of you will enter and we will see if SCP-127 is able to remember a bonded individual even without the same attire."

To make sure each CD understands their part, I will ask them once again if they each understand, if not I will explain to them what they need to do in simpler terms.

To further attempt to make the test results accurate, I will ask if any CD's have had previous experience with bonding with SCP-127, if they have, then their knowledge and experience will be useful, as such I will select them to be the CD that bonds with SCP-127.

After selecting the CD that will bond with SCP-127, then the test may be commenced.

I will let the SD know that they can send in the first CD so that the test can begin, whilst the other two CD's will remain in the briefing room.

During

Once inside, I will order the CD to introduce himself to SCP-127 and ask if SCP-127 would like to dance.

I will also tell the CD to compliment SCP-127 and positively communicate with him.

As such, once the CD has bonded with SCP-127 then I will tell the SD to escort the CD out of the containment chamber and take them to the changing room where they will equip an FP uniform.

Once the SD returns with the CD dressed in FP all three CD's will enter the containment chamber and SCP-127's reactions will be noted.

In the event that SCP-127 does not notice any differences, the test will be concluded and the SD will escort the CD's out of the containment chamber.

Whilst if SCP-127 does recognise the CD in FP attire, its interactions and how it notices the CD will be noted, proving that SCP-127 is able to retain memories, leading to my further understanding of SCP-127 which is that it's an extremely intelligent entity.

After

Once I believe that there is no further point in continuing the test, I will deem it concluded.

Before the CD's are escorted out once more of SCP-127, they will be ordered to thank SCP-127 for its time.

The SD will escort the three CD's out of the chamber and return them back to CDC. Though, before returning them, the CD in the FP uniform will be taken into the changing room and will equip the CD uniform once again.

TESTING RESULTS:

The CD that bonds with SCP-127 will now be referred to as CD-1.

- *As per expected based on prior experience, when CD-1 asked SCP-127 "Do you like to dance?" SCP-127 nodded in addition to "Would you like to dance?" SCP-127 nodded once more and began dancing when CD-1 did so as well.*
- *SCP-127's form of dancing is by swaying from side to side. After a short while SCP-127 began shooting at the target's within the containment chamber, which was then followed up with a compliment from CD-1 of the range and aim at which SCP-127 possessed. SCP-127 may have been attempting to show off its capabilities and how powerful it is to gain CD-1's approval or intimidate CD-1. The conversation continued further when I instructed the CD to keep communicating until eventually, SCP-127 walked towards CD-1 and transformed into its gun state, indicating that the bond had been formed. This was different from the previous experience when testing upon SCP-127 as when it bonded previously it circled the individual indicating that a bond had been formed. I found the two different forms of bonding quite different, perhaps*

SCP-127 is influenced by the individual it bonds with, leading to it to have various indications for when a bond has formed in different scenarios. My hypothesis could be further explored in other tests.

- *After undering that a bond had been formed, I ordered the SD to bring CD-1 out of the containment chamber and escort them to equip an FP uniform.*
- *Meanwhile, after CD-1 had left the containment chamber without picking SCP-127 up, the entity looked a bit disappointed. Perhaps this explains why SCP-127 transformed into its gun state, it wanted to be held by the bonded individual to express their connection through physical touch. This reaffirms that SCP-127's actions and personality mimics a dog, as dog's show affection through physical touch by their 'owners' by being patted which a dog may respond to by cuddling with their owner. Essentially, I believe that when SCP-127 transforms into a gun, it's attempting to share a connection through physical touch.*
- *Once the SD had returned with CD-1 equipped with the FP uniform, all three CDs were sent into the containment chamber of SCP-127.*
- *From a distance of about a metre, SCP-127 inspected them by looking at them, then faced the CD in the middle (CD-1) and moved in front of him.*
- *SCP-127 then transformed once more into a gun in front of CD-1. I only believe that SCP-127 due to my previous point above, not indicating that CD-1 should shoot the other CD's that it was with.*
- *After this occurred, I concluded the test as there was no further point in continuing the test.*

RESULTS

CONCLUSION:

According to my test results I am able to confirm my hypothesis that SCP-127 is a highly intelligent sentient anomaly which can indeed retain memories. Even though CD-1 had bonded to SCP-127 and then was removed and re-introduced to SCP-127 in an completely different attire with two other CD's dressed like CD-1 prior to bonding with SCP-127, SCP-127 was still able to determine that an bond shared between an individual and itself as SCP-127 identified the individual, perhaps by their features/scent and then transformed into its gun state. My research confirms that SCP-127 possesses cognitive abilities of being able to recall information through its memory. This allows SCP-127 to process and understand information, applying the knowledge to recognise others that are bonded with it. This opens a window into further research that I will investigate further such as other cognitive abilities that SCP-127 possesses such as its attention span. As such, perhaps SCP-127's specialised eye potentially 'scans' individual's faces and compares them to faces stored within its memory to identify whether they are a threat or are friendly towards SCP-127 and have a connection with SCP-127. As for the 'scent' that an individual may possess which can be determined and identified by SCP-127 is another method used by SCP-127 to recognise an individual that has bonded with SCP-127 and therefore trusts. The potential research that can be conducted can be explored as to how this could be implemented towards SCP-127's containment strategies that could be developed based on its cognitive response to others. If the foundation treats SCP-127 with respect and when seen, interactions with SCP-127 are positive then perhaps SCP-127 will view the foundational personnel as ally's and will assist the foundation as an deployable weapon which may be able to be used against rioting CD or SCP breaches, depending on how SCP-127 views the CD/SCP as hostile or not. Though, the usage of SCP-127 as a weapon, does pose the risk of danger towards it, so measure's would have to be put in place to ethically make sure that SCP-127 remains unharmed by danger. If SCP-127 needs to be re-contained due to a potential danger that could negatively affect SCP-127, then it is likely that SCP-127 will follow individuals that share a bond with it, as those individuals have shown SCP-127 kindness so, SCP-127 see's bonded individual's as trustworthy. As such, I believe I have answered my
