Learning Mastery in Canvas

Canvas can help you track student progress on your course or program outcomes, but first you'll need to have things set up for your course.

Step 1: Enter or Find Outcomes.

Step 2: Add your Outcomes in your Rubrics



Step 3: Use the rubrics to assess students.


 Even if a student does well, don't skip the rubric and just give them a grade! For the data to be accurate, it all has to be entered!

Step 4: View the Learning Mastery Gradebook


To access the Learning Mastery Gradebook, Go to Grades on your course menu.



• Click the drop-down carrot next to "Gradebook."



Select "Learning Mastery."




Below is an example of a report.



The report provides a color-coding system to identify students' progress on each outcome.

• Hovering over the name of an outcome provides additional insights for the class.



Clicking the name of a student will also provide more information for that student.



• To return to the full grade center, click the drop-down carrot next to Learning Mastery Gradebook and select "Traditional Gradebook."



Be sure to access the report again after you grade additional assignments that use the same outcomes so that you can see students' progress!
