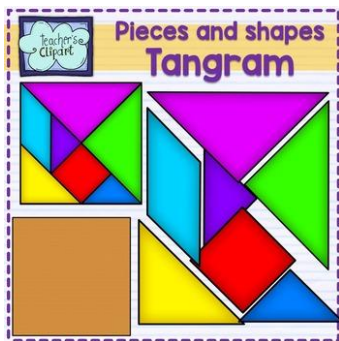

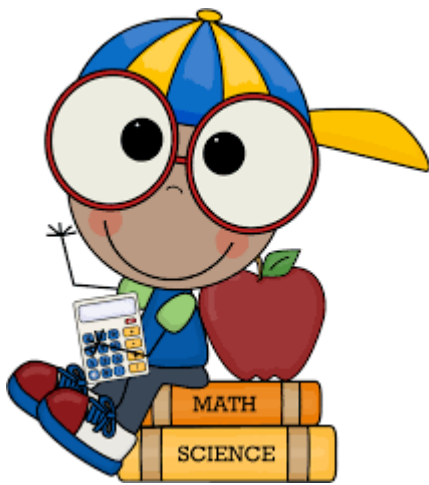


*Are You Ready for 1st grade READING??

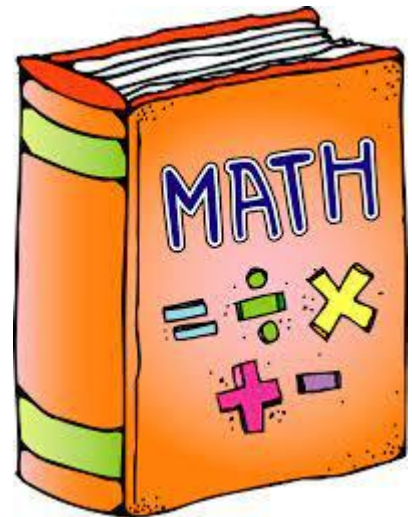


*Are You Ready for 1st grade MATH??

Current Grades K-5

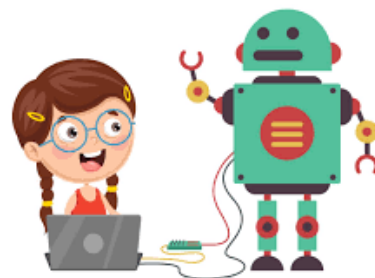

Current Grades 3-8

Intro into Basketball

Current Grades K-3

Advanced Basketball

Current Grades 4-Up

Get Fit

Current Grades K-Up

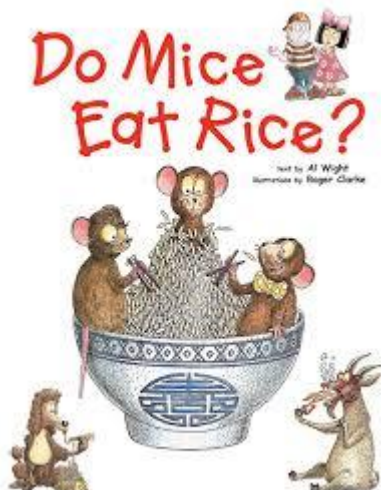
Taste What is Cooking Around the Globe

Remedial Math

Current Grades 7-8

Remedial Language Arts/Reading

Current Grades 7-8

This course will be offered to students who have failed either 1st or 2nd semester, or both semesters of Language Arts/Reading credits. This course is also available if you have remedial Language Arts/Reading needs. Please indicate what grade level you need to complete and whether it is for 1 or 2 semesters.



Students needing to complete one year of credit will have additional class assignments required.



Credit Recovery Class

Current Grades 9-12

This alternative education program is for students who have not been successful in the regular classroom and/or have a need for an alternative approach. Students who have failed or done poorly can work with the alternative education staff to make up any missed credits. Independent study, Odysseyware courses, and small-group work will be utilized.

ALL students are expected to follow school rules and expectations. If students are unable to follow these rules and expectations, students may be removed from the remedial and/or credit recovery courses for the remainder of the summer school term.
