Royal Security Act

Proposed/passed by High Council
Approved by Royal Supreme Court
Approved by the Supreme Ruler, High Prince James Stratus

- Grants the Lord Protector primarily, with the following in secondary order of authority to override His Majesty or members of the Royal Family when it concerns matters of their personal safety, most especially when their own life is at risk (secondary authority individuals in order of authority: Commandant of His Majesty's Royal Guard (if different from the Lord Protector). Praetorian for Defense, Minister of Defense, Admiral of the Royal Command Fleet
- 2. Their only duty shall be to protect and secure their protectees. If they are in danger, it shall be their duty to move them to a secure location straight away.
- 3. They must inform the Royal Protectees they are protecting them/acting under authority of the Royal Security Act. If they are bringing a Royal Family member against their will to a secure location, they must notify the Throne and Royal Supreme Court under this Act. If they are bringing a Throne member against their will to a secure location, they must inform the Royal Supreme Court, under the obligations of the Act, lest they be accused/and or charged of(or with) high treason,
