

Student Growth Measures

Up to 50% of a teacher's evaluation comes from how much their students learn throughout the year. Student growth measures are used to determine the amount of impact a teacher had on their students' learning by measuring student progress between two points in time.

Types of Student Growth Measures

1. Value-Added
2. Approved Vendor Assessments
3. Locally Determined Measures
