



Kids Sewing Camp

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We will start by learning about sewing machines and how they work. In our first class we will practice sewing accurate seams and make a pillowcase. In our second class we will learn how to safely use a rotary cutter and start cutting the squares for our pillow cover. Our last two classes will be all about laying out our patchwork, matching corners, and completing our pillow cover. The pillow form is included with the class fee.

The class is designed to teach your child to be able to do basic sewing. For this reason, the classes are limited to the students only. The class is for kiddos 10 years old and up.

I hope that by the end of our classes you will be “hooked” on sewing and you will be inspired and ready to jump into many new projects of your choosing.

Supplies:

- Scissors-we will use these mainly for cutting threads
- Rotary cutter
- 18” x 24” cutting mat
- 24” x 6” ruler or 24” x 8” ruler
- Pins
- Tape measure
- Seam ripper
- Cotton thread-neutral color

- Fabric for pillowcase: 2/3 yard for main body

1/3 yard for cuff

1/8 yard for accent strip

- Fabric for 16 patch pillow cover (this will cover a 24” pillow form)
5 fat quarters (18” x 22” piece of fabric) of various colors and prints
2/3 yard -this is for the back side of pillow
Pillow form is included in class fee

If you have a sewing machine that you sew on at home, please bring it. Please bring the manual also. It's good to get to know how to sew on your own machine, but if you don't have a machine, we will provide one for you.
