

Resolution: Academic Integrity Policy

Whereas according to the current policy and current standards in place for recording academic integrity offenses there is nothing that mentions the issues involving artificial intelligence.

Whereas We believe the solution to holding students accountable in the long run is to encourage faculty to report the offenses to the school dean using the proper procedures already in place so that the proper penalty can be issued in each instance.

Whereas currently there is a rapid expansion of AI tools that are available for students which could lead to increases in academic integrity violations.

Be it resolved; faculty have the right to ask students to meet in person in order to determine authorship of assignments.

Be it further resolved Unless a student is explicitly told they are to use AI, students may not use AI such as ChatGPT to create assignments that should be original to the student.

Be it further resolved that copying and/or generating content without appropriate citation is considered a violation of academic integrity policy.
