

TLP2 UXR Home Screen Survey Draft

Background and Objective: The Design team requested assistance from the Research team about what should be included in the Home screen of the app. We felt that we did not have enough information from existing research to be able to adequately respond to that request. We believe a survey of potential TLP app users about their expectations for the app, learning preferences, and organization of content will inform decisions about content and design of the home screen. Phase 2 is ending before we can deploy and analyze findings, so we have prepared a potential survey for Phase 3 Researchers to use.

We divided the survey into 7 sections to gather basic information about participants and why they are interested in learning Taíno and their previous experience with the language. We intended to recruit people who identify as Taíno, as we have done in previous research. Additionally, we have included questions that will provide insights for the new Curriculum Design team.

Structure of Survey:

3. Experience with Taíno language (4 Qs)
4. Questions about content and organization (7 Qs)
5. Learning preferences (6 Qs)
6. Desired home screen feature (1 Q)
