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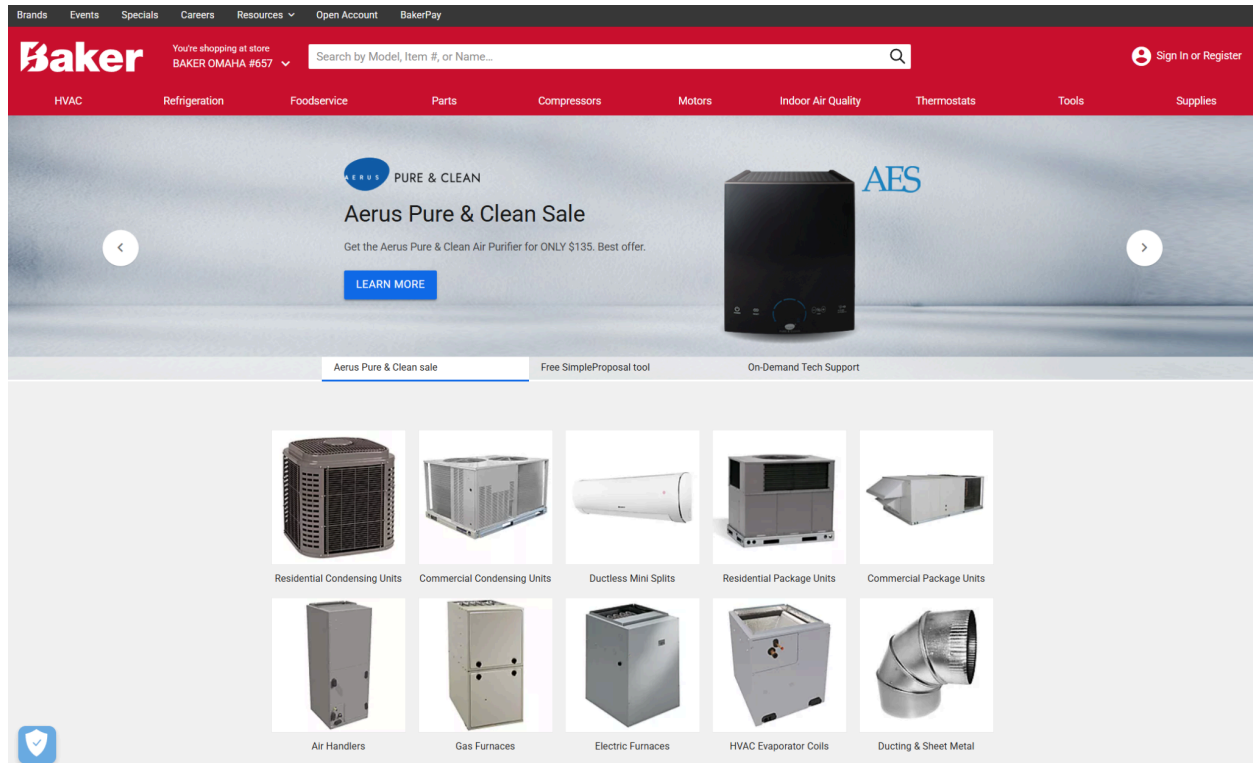

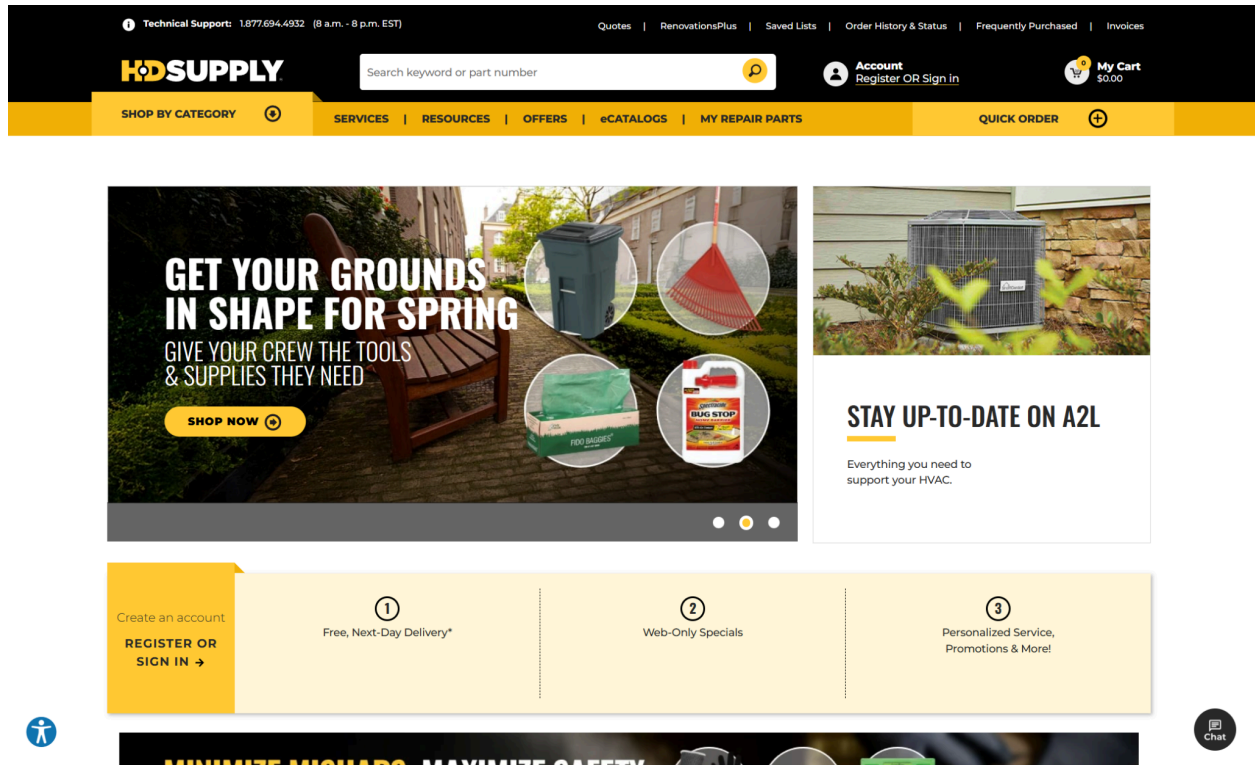

Factors to Consider When Evaluating Distributors

While competitive bulk pricing is essential, inventory variety is even more important. If one wholesaler has all the parts a business needs, they won't have to visit a patchwork of suppliers to restock. This will help them provide consistent HVAC service.

A distributor should have parts, accessories and tools. This includes switches, fuses, meters, fan blades, relays, terminals, hydronics, adhesives, motors, capacitors, gauges and coils. Testing instruments and packaged units are bonuses. Ordering prebuilt thermostats or indoor air quality systems is a good strategy for projects with tight timelines.

Some distributors even carry the tools needed to complete jobs, such as dust masks, leak detectors, drill bits, batteries and drop cloths. The more SKUs they have, the more unique products they carry. Decision-makers should also evaluate category types and the consistency of offerings.

Aside from inventory variety, HVAC professionals should evaluate shipping policies and delivery time, considering prices, speed and discounts. Is delivery the only option, or can they pick up goods at the distribution center? Does the company charge to bring shipments inside?

Frequently Asked Questions About HVAC Distributors

If HVAC business owners still have questions about pricing, ordering or shipping, they should refer to these frequently asked questions.

What is the difference between a distributor and a wholesaler?

A distributor works directly with manufacturers under contract to sell specific brands. The OEMs license it to sell their products in a certain region, which connects them to new markets or channels. A wholesaler buys these goods in bulk and resells them to businesses.

How do I get the best prices on bulk orders?

To get the best prices on bulk orders, HVAC businesses should compare suppliers, increase order size and wait for discounts. Many distributors carry the same parts from the same OEMs, so getting a better deal may be a matter of waiting. If they don't have time to wait, they can attempt to negotiate.

The 2 PO method involves submitting two purchase orders, one small and one large. Say the larger order needs a 15% discount to justify the quantity. Business owners call the wholesaler and offer to make the second, larger purchase, but only if the volume discount is added. The smaller order is a psychological trick that gives them leverage.

How are shipping costs handled for large orders?

Many wholesalers only offer free shipping if customers place orders over a certain dollar amount. As such, charges are usually waived for bulk orders. However, there may be weight limitations or geographic restrictions. If the shipment's weight is too high or the distance traveled is too far, additional charges may apply. Policies vary from distributor to distributor.

How do I evaluate a distributor's return policy?

Business owners should evaluate the time limit, restocking fee and refund policies carefully. Are shipping costs refundable? What about if the product is damaged in transit? They should also review the order cancellation policy.

It may be more time- and cost-effective to cancel the order after it is placed but before it ships. Once the product leaves the distribution center, it is subject to the return policy, which may not be as forgiving.

Choosing Between the Most Affordable Electrical Supply Distributors for Bulk Orders

Professionals providing HVAC services need to keep critical parts on hand. Rather than wasting time waiting for orders to arrive for each project, they should order in bulk. Most of the affordable electrical and HVAC supply distributors offer volume discounts for bulk orders on top of flash deals, web-exclusive discounts and personalized promotions.
