Important Information for Year 6 Parents

Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you have all been enjoying the summer so far, and that the SATs period was a positive experience for your child. It was great to see so many families at our Welcome Evening in May.

I wanted to write to you with some more updates from Lift New Forest as we approach the final few weeks of term. Whilst I appreciate there is a lot of information in this letter, please do read everything carefully so that you are clear on the next steps

Transition Days - Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd July

We are really looking forward to welcoming your child to Lift New Forest for our two transition days on **Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd July**.

The arrival time on both days is 9.15am. Year 6 students and their parents and carers should arrive at the main entrance by 9.15am where they will be met by our staff. Parents and carers can then leave and students will be taken into school and organised into their tutor groups. I would like each child to bring a hard copy of a **piece of written work that they are particularly proud of** on their first transition day. This will allow us to see and celebrate their work as soon as they enter our school.

The finish time on Thursday 2nd July is 2.45pm. Students may either be collected from the main gate or, if appropriate, make their own way home.

On Friday 3rd July, we would like to invite all parents to arrive at school at 2.15pm for a welcome celebration and short presentation with myself and other school staff. Students can then leave with their parents or carers from approximately 2.30pm.

Ms Jones (Assistant Principal) will share some further details about our Transition Days prior to 2nd July.

Year Group Leadership - September 2026

I am delighted to let you know that we have now appointed key staff to work with Year 7 next year.

The year group will be led by **Mr Benson** (Lead Practitioner), who has six years' experience

as a Head of Year at Lift New Forest, and is a familiar and friendly face amongst our school community. Mr Benson will be supported by **Mr Avery** (Assistant Head of Year), who will be a key point of contact for you as we move forwards.

Mr Benson and Mr Avery will be supported by a fantastic team of tutors. The Year 7 tutors will be Ms Mengham (Science), Miss Hall (MFL), Ms Frosina (Science) and Mr Britton (Maths).

You will be able to meet your child's tutor as part of the transition programme.

We Will Rock You!

Following the incredible success of last year's production of Matilda Jr., we are delighted to announce that our next school production will be **We Will Rock You!** Performances are planned for the end of September 2026.

We are really looking forward to giving our students another fantastic opportunity to develop their confidence, creativity, and teamwork both on and off the stage. Taking part in a school production is a rewarding experience, but it also comes with a number of important responsibilities.

Management Information System - Arbor

As is the case in most of our feeder primary schools, we will be using Arbor, our Management Information System (MIS), to securely house your child's information. Over the next few weeks, you will receive a series of emails to help you get started.

To make this process as smooth as possible, we have broken the setup into four manageable stages:

Stage	Focus	Action Required
1: Access	The Parent Portal	Look for an automated invite email from Arbor. You can use the web version or download the app via Apple or Android.
2: Profile	Vital Information	You will receive a second letter with instructions on adding medical details, consents, and additional guardians.
3: Safety	eSafety Agreement	You must sign this agreement via the app.
4: Finance	Arbor Pay	Information will follow on how to pay for school meals, trips, and activities.

Free School Meals

If your child is currently receiving Free School Meals, this information will normally transfer from their primary school and you should not need to make a further application.

From September 2026, **free school meals in England are expanding** to include all children in households receiving Universal Credit.
