


How to Enable Pop Ups for NWEA Testing


For your student to test via the NWEA online testing environment, browser popups must be enabled to initiate testing.

Below are basic instructions regarding how to enable popups in Google Chrome, Firefox, Safari, and Microsoft Edge (on PCs). Please note that browsers vary by computer system and version number. The instructions given might be slightly different than presented.

Google Chrome

Google Chrome prevents pop-ups from automatically appearing and cluttering your screen. Whenever the browser blocks pop-ups for a site, an icon appears on the top-right in the address bar. Click the icon to see the pop-ups that have been blocked or to manage pop-up settings for the site.

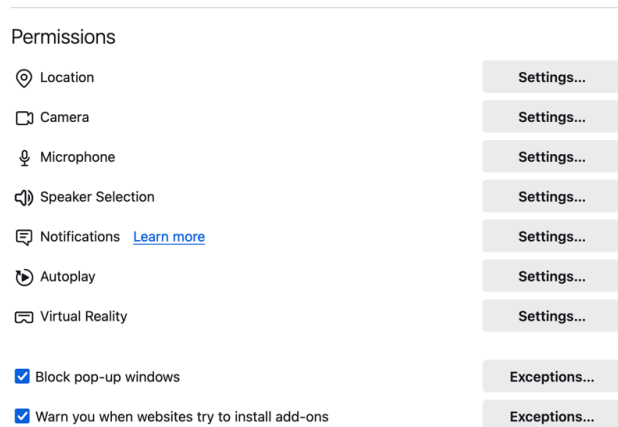
- Change your default pop-ups & redirects settings.
 - On your computer, open **Chrome**.
 - At the top right, click More  > **Settings**.
 - Click **Privacy and security** > **Site Settings** > **Pop-ups and redirects**.
 - Choose the option that you want as your default setting.

- Allow pop-ups and redirects from a site.
 - On your computer, open **Chrome**.
 - Go to a page where pop-ups are blocked.
 - In the address bar, click Pop-up blocked .
 - Click the link for the pop-up you want to check.
 - To always allow pop-ups for the site, select **Always allow pop-ups and redirects from [site]** > **Done**. The site will be added to the exceptions list, which you can manage in the Content Settings dialog.

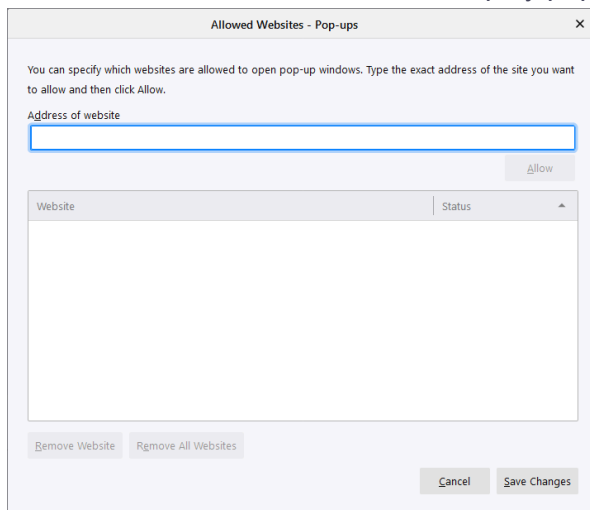
Firefox

To access the pop-up blocker settings:

- In the Menu bar at the top of the screen, click Firefox and then select Preferences or Settings
- Select the Privacy & Security panel.
- Go down to the *Permissions* section.
 - Uncheck the box next to **Block pop-up windows** to disable the pop-up blocker altogether.



- Or Click the **Exceptions...** button to the right of **Block pop-up windows** to open a dialog box to choose which sites are allowed to display pop-ups.

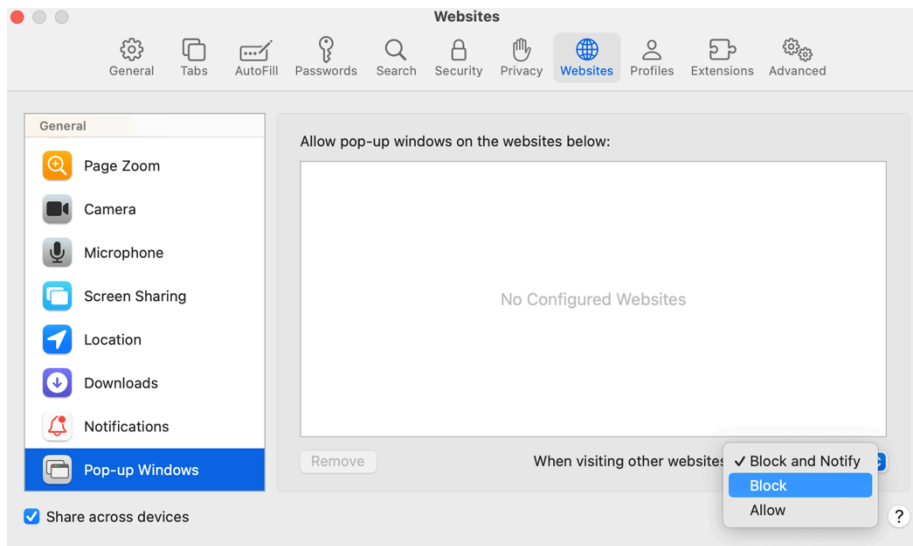


- The dialog box offers you the following choices:
 - Type or paste the address of a website and click the **Allow** button to add it to the list of sites that will be allowed to open pop-up windows.
 - Select a website from the list and click the **Remove Website** button to remove it from the exceptions list.
 - Click the **Remove All Websites** button to remove all websites from the exceptions list.
 - Click the **Save Changes** button to apply your changes.

Safari



- In the Safari app on your Mac, choose Safari > Preferences (or Settings), then click Websites.
- Click Pop-up Windows.
- Allow pop-up windows for:
 - Allow pop-up windows on the websites below: Type or paste the address of a website.
 - All websites: Click the “When visiting other websites” pop-up menu (bottom right), then choose the option you want.



Microsoft Edge®

- Click the Settings and More ... button on the upper-right side of the browser.
- Click Settings.
- Click Cookies and Site Permissions.
- Select Pop-ups and redirects and switch to toggle it between Off and On.
