There are many <sup>2</sup>advantages to shopping online rather than in stores. These include the ease, low prices, and nearly <sup>3</sup>unlimited choice of items. Internet shopping is nice because one can shop at any time at home, at work, or on a laptop computer in your <sup>4</sup>favorite coffee shop. There is no need to worry about traffic, high gas prices, parking, store crowds, difficult <sup>5</sup>salespeople, or long lines.
- 3. Before buying something online, many people <sup>6</sup>**educate themselves** about the items they want to get. They do this by going online and comparing the different <sup>7</sup>**features** and prices of the products offered.
