## BIBLE STUDIES

**Esther's Girls Bible Study:** Women of all ages meet Tuesday mornings from 9:30-11:00 am in the Council Room starting September 9 with study on The Life of Peter beginning September 16. Led by Joan Hamstra and Lu Lofe.

**Joy Guild Bible Study:** Women of all ages. Meets on Wednesday afternoons from 1:00-2:30 pm in the Youth Room starting September 17. Ron Nydam and Pastor Sheri lead a study on Malachi.

**Men's Tuesday Morning Bible Study:** Men of all ages. Meets on Tuesdays from 7:30-8:30 am to study the minor prophets starting September 9. Led by Pastor Eric Snyder. New location at Hope beginning February 17, 2026.

**Men's Thursday Evening Bible Study:** Men of all ages. Meets on Thursdays from 6:30-8:00 pm in the Council Room starting September 18. Dave Lofe leads a study on Job.

**Spanish Bible Study / Estudio Biblia En Español:** Nuestro Estudio Bíblico en español se reúne los domingos por la mañana a las 9:30 am en la sala juvenil.

**Women's Bible Study:** Women of all ages meet Tuesday evenings from 6:30-8:00 pm in the Youth Room starting September 16 with introductions and to consider studies. Led by Pastor Sheri.

## SOCIAL CLUBS

**Book Club:** Intergenerational (high school age +). Meets on the third Wednesday of the month to discuss a different book each month beginning September 2025.

**Dinner Club:** Mixed aged groups of 7-8 adults that meet once a month for dinner. This is potluck style and the houses rotate each month.

**Garden Club:** Intergenerational (all ages). Maintain the vegetable garden in front of the church as needed during the growing season.

**Golden Girls:** Women aged 55+. Activities may include dinner once a month, social outings, lunch, craft nights, game nights, etc. Led by Lois Wiersum.

**Hope's Hikers:** Intergenerational (all ages). Typically meets the first Monday morning of every month spring through summer for an easy to moderate hike throughout the surrounding Denver area followed by lunch. Monthly sign ups are included in Hope Happenings. Led by Ann Parker.

## CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES

**Check In:** A friendly face who greets all of our children and their parents and assists families with printing name tags for their children before service.

**Children's Message:** Adults are needed to give a 5-minute children's message during Sunday service that demonstrates the sermon concept to children.

**Classroom Teacher (PreK-K, grades 1-3, grades 4-5):** Adult (18+) volunteers who instruct children in weekly Bible lessons and crafts downstairs after the children's message helping to cultivate their blooming faith. Curriculum is provided. You can set your availability. Background check is required.

**Generation Spark Mentor Program:** A mentorship program pairing 6th graders through 24-year-olds with adults aged 45 and older. Training provided for mentors. Mentees are needed too!

**Kids' Corner:** Play with kids at a station at our monthly C.A.R.E. Closet meal and distribution night.

**Nursery Worker:** Adult (18+) volunteers who welcome babies and toddlers as they arrive and provide a warm, nurturing environment during Sunday service while they are in your care. You can set your availability. Background check is required.

**Prayer Partner:** Adults will be paired with a child in our children's ministries program to intentionally pray for them through the ministry year.

**Scouts (Pack/Troop 194):** For youth grades K-12. Meets on Monday nights September through May at Hope Fellowship. Joining Night is September 8, 2025.

**Student Helper:** Youth in grades 6 through 12 who serve alongside adult volunteers to assist with crafts, set up, and clean up material in the nursery, PreK-K, or grades 1-3 classroom.

## LOVE IN ACTION

**C.A.R.E. Closet Evening:** Intergenerational (middle school age and up). Opportunities include preparing and serving food, assisting with registration, filling up bags with supplies, helping with prayer ministry, playing with children, set up and clean up. Commitment is the 3rd Wednesday evening (5:30-7:00 pm) of every month.

**C.A.R.E. Closet Prep:** Intergenerational (middle school age and up). Sorting, stocking, and preparing supplies prior to CARE Closet evening. Commitment is 1-2 days or evenings a month (~5 hours). You set your availability.

**Hope's Angels:** An annual program that provides Christmas gifts to children affiliated with Hope by selecting them from a Christmas tree ornament and blind gifting them at a special dinner. Meet once a month September through November to plan, coordinate, and execute our Christmas Hope's Angels event in December.

**Meal Ministry:** Prepare and bring homemade meals to congregants going through challenging life circumstances.

## CHURCH OPERATIONS

**Audio Team:** Adult volunteers act as Audio/Recording Engineer willing to learn and operate our sound system for Sunday services and other needs as they arise (weddings, funerals, etc.). You can set your availability. Training provided.

**Community Life Team:** A team of middle school through adult volunteers willing to help plan, coordinate, and execute intergenerational gatherings and events for our church family and the community. Meet once a month. Be present at gatherings.

**Drink Prep:** Prepare and set out lemonade before Sunday service. Put away coffee and lemonade after service. Training will be provided. You can set your own availability.

**Facilities Team:** A team of high school and adult volunteers willing to help keep the building and grounds operational and clean. Meet once a month. Fulfill requests as needs arise.

**Greeter:** Middle school through adult volunteers receive everyone in a warm, friendly way on Sunday mornings. Work in teams of two to shake hands and welcome each individual entering the church. Set your own availability.

**Kitchen Team:** Assist in the kitchen for functions held at the church as needed (weddings, funerals, potlucks, celebrations, events, etc.) Set out food, clean and put away used kitchen items, and wipe down counters/sinks upon completion. You can set your availability.

**Library Coordinator:** Organize, manage, maintain, and promote the church's library resources.

**Liturgy/Bible Reader:** Reads assigned Scripture passages and liturgical elements during the worship service.

**Safe Church Team:** A team of adult volunteers (18+) who work to put together and implement policies that promote safety, health, and well-being for all who are a part of our staff, leadership, ministries, worship, and all who walk through our doors. Meet as needed.

**Seasonal Decorations Team:** Middle school through adult volunteers willing to help decorate our sanctuary and Gathering Place for seasonal changes (Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter, ordinary time). You can set your availability.

**Security Team:** A team of adult volunteers (18+) who provide a safe and secure environment during worship services and throughout the week. You can set your availability and choose security during the week and/or security on Sunday mornings. Training provided. Meet as needed.

**Singer/Instrumentalist:** Leads the congregation in worship through music, using voice or instruments to glorify God and encourage heartfelt praise.

**Toy Cleaner:** Assist the Children's Ministries Director in a deep cleaning of all nursery and children's church toys 2-3 times per year.

**Visual Tech Team:** Middle school through adult volunteers willing to learn and operate our camera and livestream equipment and/or our ProPresenter slide presentations for Sunday services and other needs as they arise (weddings, funerals, etc.). You can set your availability. Training provided.

**Wedding/Funeral Coordinator:** Coordinate wedding and funeral services, working with families, the pastor, and audio and visual volunteers to make sure everything from food to slideshows is organized.

**Worship Planning Team:** A team of teen through adult volunteers who plan the structure, flow, and content of select Sunday morning worship services including songs, themes, liturgies, and prayers.
