At Markham Model United Nations, we understand that engaging with certain topics of discussion may be distressing for delegates. Everyone comes from different backgrounds and experiences, so our entire team is committed to ensuring an equitable and enjoyable conference experience for all participants. This committee discusses several topics with varying levels of real-world application, so we ask that delegates be mindful of how they act and address the content of this background guide. The material associated with this committee may be perceived as controversial, so it is important that delegates recognize possible differences in opinion and find solutions in a diplomatic and respectful manner.

At MarkMUN, we are people first and competitors second. We encourage all delegates to take part in committee research and discussions in an equitable manner. All stakeholders at MarkMUN conferences are expected to adhere to our <u>Code of Conduct</u>, especially when engaging with possibly sensitive topics. Additionally, we ask that delegates recognize the varied levels of comfort their peers may have with the committee material and adapt accordingly.

In signing our conference Code of Conduct, delegates have already agreed to participate in an equitable and professional manner for the duration of the conference. Any violations of conference equity policy will be dealt with at the discretion of the Secretariat. If you wish to voice an equity concern regarding this background guide or any other committee materials, feel free to contact our Director-General, Luca, at dg.markmun@gmail.com. Here at Markham Model United Nations, we strive to provide a safe, productive and equitable environment for debate that all delegates, faculty, and staff can take part in!

Please note that **delegates will only be allowed to switch committees for equity reasons**. All delegates are **expected to participate in the committee they are assigned** to unless a Committee Change Request is submitted. If you wish to submit a Committee Change Request after reading this content warning, please do the following:

- 1. Email our Director-General, Luca, at dg.markmun@gmail.com and provide an explanation as to why you wish to switch committees. Once our team has had a chance to review your request, you will be contacted and provided with a new committee position.
- 2. If you are uncomfortable with the alternative position offered, our Secretariat will communicate with you regarding next steps. For logistical reasons, please ensure that you make any committee change requests at least three days before the conference.

Land Acknowledgement

We affirm that we are all treaty people and acknowledge that the York Region District School Board is located on the lands of two treaties. These treaties have been signed with the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation and the First Nations of the Williams Treaties who are: the Mississaugas of Alderville, Curve Lake, Hiawatha, Scugog Island; and the Chippewas of Beausoleil, Rama, and Georgina Island who is our closest neighbour and partner in education. To honour this agreement, we will take up our responsibility to be respectful of their traditions, knowledge and inherent rights as sovereign nations. We will respect their relationship with these lands and recognize that our connection to this land is through the continued relationship with these First Nations, and we acknowledge our shared responsibility to respect and care for the land and waters for future generations.





MarkMUN is proud to be a tech-friendly conference, and we encourage delegates to bring personal devices for notes and working papers. Delegates will be provided with access to free Wi-Fi on the day of the conference to connect to. Delegates will NOT be provided with personal devices to borrow at the conference. Our conference is strictly AI-free and has a zero-tolerance policy on the use of Artificial Intelligence and Chatbot tools. This includes writing position papers, resolution papers and notes to other delegates and/or the crisis backroom. Delegates who are found to be using AI will be subject to serious consequences at the discretion of the Secretariat, including possible expulsion from the conference.

Awards

At MarkMUN 2024, delegates will have a chance to compete for a variety of individual **awards** that highlight their abilities in speaking, negotiating, teamwork and creativity. Each committee will offer the following awards:

- One **Best Delegate** Award (3 points)
 - Awarded to the delegate who expresses the best overall quality of debate, leadership ability, cooperation and resolution-writing skills in committee
- One **Outstanding Delegate** Award (2 points)
 - Awarded to the delegate who expresses outstanding ability in their speaking and negotiation skills and contributes to resolutions formed in committee
- One/Two **Honourable Mention** Award(s) (1 point)
 - Awarded to the delegate who goes above and beyond expectations in debate and resolution-writing in committee

Slack Etiquette

Delegate Notes

Delegates are permitted to use **direct messaging** to communicate with other delegates, similar to how written notes are used to send messages between delegates at most conferences. The difference is that delegate notes <u>will not be equity screened</u> since direct messages between delegates cannot be checked by our Equity Officers. Thus, the <u>onus to identify and report messages which may violate the MarkMUN Code of Conduct is on delegates.</u>

We know this may seem frightening, which is why our Equity Officers are ready and available during the conference to assist you and hear out your concerns. Our EOs have a direct line of communication with our Secretary-General, the *de facto* Chief of Equity for the conference, who is ready and available at all times to address major equity violations. For further details, please refer to our Code of Conduct (see <u>Policies</u>)

Group Chats

Delegates are permitted to create group chat rooms to congregate with each other and discuss possible blocs/resolution paper ideas. A mandatory requirement for all created group chats is the addition of the committee's Equity Officer and Director to monitor for any possible equity violations. This is a non-negotiable stipulation, and any delegates involved in any group chats that do not have staff added will be considered to have violated this Delegate Handbook and the conference Code of Conduct (see Policies).

Crisis Notes

Delegates in a crisis committee are permitted to use Slack to send crisis notes to the backroom team. This will take place by directly messaging the committee email and a crisis analyst will reply as promptly as possible. Recognizing that crisis committees can regularly experience backlog, we ask all of our crisis delegates to be patient with responses and only send one note at a time to ensure an equitable experience for all.

Messaging Staff

Delegates <u>should not be communicating with their committee staffers</u> via Slack unless one of the following situations applies:

- 1. They are in a crisis committee and wish to send **crisis notes**, in which case they should only be messaging the <u>committee email</u>,
- 2. They wish to report an **equity concern** privately to the <u>Equity Officer</u> that impacts their immediate safety and/or wellbeing
 - a. Any equity concerns that are not **life-threatening health/safety concerns** should first be reported via the anonymous Equity Reporting Form (see <u>Forms</u>)
