OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION

Occupational coursework offered within the school district are those in business, home economics, and technology. The district offers other opportunities through cooperative programs through the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Nassau County (BOCES – Barry Tech and GC Tech). A student who elects to pursue a career training program offered at BOCES must be a student in good standing, who adheres to the high school attendance policy, and who has met certain core requirements for high school graduation. Students who are contemplating election of vocational training are advised to contact the high school Guidance Department early in their sophomore (10th grade) year so that offerings and requirements can be carefully, thoroughly, and individually reviewed. A meeting with the Guidance Counselor and a visit to observe the program in operation must be made by the student and interested parents. In order to permit the school district to prepare a budget that realistically reflects charges of tuition (no cost to student or parent), applications must be completed in a timely manner. Students who submit applications late will be placed on a waiting list. Programs approved by the Island Trees School District are listed below.
