Job Interview

Choose an adult to interview about their work. Set up a time for the interview.

Review the following questions for the discussion. Draft additional questions.

Your goal is to discover why your interviewee chose their profession.

Questions:

- 1. What initially attracted you to your area of work?
- 2. Is that what still appeals to you about it?
- 3. What were the most important factors to you in choosing an area of work?
- 4. What do you like and dislike about your work?
- 5. What, if anything, would make you choose to leave your work?
- 6. Do you have things that you worry about in your work? Any ethical concerns? Are your concerns shared by others? How would you like to see them handled?
- 7. Have you ever been involved in a situation at work that violated your sense of right and wrong?

Conduct the interview and record the answers. Then, complete a personal reflection about your subject's response to your questions. For example, were there any surprises? Did the responses inspire you to think about something new or different?
