A PEEK AT OUR WEEK:

This week we will have a full week of learning! We are starting a new story in **Reading** called <u>Diary of a Spider</u>. The fun story helps us to look at writing from a different perspective. We will be exploring the story (and spiders) in different ways. In **math** we will be assessing unit 1: *number sense* and taking a peek at unit 2: *Adding 2 digit numbers*. Then, in **Social Studies**, we are starting a new unit: *Farm to Table*.
