Treasurer- Andrew Foster

- Treasurer report attached.
 - The PTSO ended January with a cash balance of \$26,455.80.
 - Through January, total revenues are \$9,996 versus a budget of \$16,400. We are below budget for membership and donations by \$1,279. Tiger's den is below budget by \$4,608, but we anticipate additional sales this spring with incoming 9 th graders. Kroger funds are paid quarterly, and we expect to be on budget. The Tiger's shack has achieved its budgeted income for the year with three months remaining in the school year. Finally, we are expecting additional income from the spring Craftsmen's Classic, which is currently on budget from additional volunteer events at Richmond Raceway.
 - Looking to expenses, we have spent \$3,045 versus a budget of \$21,150. We are expecting additional expenses for Party All Night, Scholarship, Programs, Hospitality. We will likely have favorability for a few budget line items based on year to date spending.
 - For 2024-25, we budgeted a net loss of \$5,050. Based on favorable revenue sources and underspending on certain expense items, I'm anticipating the net loss will be lower than budgeted. Given our current cash balance and expected loss for the year, the PTSO remains in a strong financial position.
