

SOAKED – Code of Conduct

*This set of rules apply to everyone joining the party, to make sure
that we all can have as good of a time as possible.
As organizers we reserve ourselves the right to show people out if needed.*

We believe that everyone (bottom or top) is responsible. Please communicate physical or psychological limits or sensitivities in advance and negotiate before the scene. This party is organized according to the R.A.C.K / P.R.I.C.K philosophies (*Risk Aware Consensual Kink / Personal Responsibility Informed Consensual Kink*).

Consent is key!

Joining an ongoing scene is something that is only permitted through explicit invitation of the players. Don't touch participants or move their belongings without their permission. Even if you know a person, they might be in a headspace that isn't fitting with for example a hug - make sure to keep this in mind!

Watching is permitted, but keep a respectable distance.
If you are asked to stand back – do so.

Party safe word is “Red”, meaning Full stop.

If “Red” is called, and the scene is not stopped everyone has a responsibility to intervene. The organizers are dungeon monitors and have the right to stop a scene at any point, if they find it necessary.

This is a sober party, meaning no alcohol will be available for purchase. It is **not** allowed to bring your own alcohol/drugs into the party.

If you consumed anything before entering, make sure to notify your playpartners of this in advance, since we want to enable people to make informed decisions about their interactions, and these are substances that diminishes the capacity of reaction and can affect the ability to judge a situation. Drunk/intoxicated persons will not be allowed in/will be shown out.

Sharing is caring!

The space is limited so make sure there is room for others to make good use of it. The play spaces are not for socializing – if you are watching a scene, keep your voice down and be mindful about how you move around in the space. In case there are arguments or discussions these must take place outside the play areas.

There will be a small aftercare area, please refrain from using this as a general socializing area.

Please clean up after yourselves! Borrowed toys/tools, furniture and play areas must be cleaned and disinfected after the scene, using the provided spray bottles. Throw away used gloves, condoms, paper etc. and don't leave them on the floor or other places.

Safer sex supplies are available, make use of them. If it runs out, ask for it in the bar.

In case you are playing with blood: put something over open wounds after the scene. Keep blood play away from the bar area. Needles and staples must be put into sharps-containers after use. Bring your own or use ours.

Watersports/wet is only permitted in a designated area. If in doubt where this is – ask the organizers or at the bar.

Wax play, scat, roman/vomit and knife play is not permitted due to practical reasons.

Respect people's pronouns. If in doubt, ask and don't assume.

Photographing, filming and recording is not allowed at any time.

Phones with cameras will get a sticker to cover the cameras. You can pick up your phone to pay in the bar, but if you need to use your phone for other reasons, this is only permitted in the wardrobe.

In case you need your phone for health/accessibility reasons, you have to make an agreement with the organizers in advance.

Smoking is only allowed in the smoking room. If you exit the party you go home.

If someone is bothering you and/or breaking the rules, please notify the organizers, we will make sure during the welcome presentation that everyone knows how to spot us.

After the party: please be discreet about what went on. Of course processing your experiences with a trusted friend is ok even if they weren't at the party. Don't mention names of people if you don't know that the person is open or if not approved in advance. This includes talking about people being present at the party, not only for scenes.
