Membean:

Membean is an expectation at the beginning of class unless directed otherwise. The first ten minutes of each class will be dedicated to it. You will be receiving nine points per week for time (ten minutes per day that we are in session), accuracy (70% or higher), and Membean participation. There will be a quiz every two weeks (worth fifteen points). There is a document on our webpage's home screen that outlines the specifics of Membean. Please read it carefully.

SmartPass

SmartPass is still relatively new to our school, but it will continue to be utilized. Submit your pass request using your Chromebook. If I do not see it, please raise your hand and let me know that you have submitted one. Once you have alerted me, wait to see if the authorization goes through. There is a sign-out sheet at the front of the room that you will need to complete prior to leaving. This is a backup in case SmartPass is not working or in case there is an issue.
