Krovmaer has a firm belief that no one member is above another when it comes to the prosperity of the country. The baker, the hunter, and the warrior are of equal standing when at home. Ranking among the people is only brought to the forefront when in combat or wartime. During such times the hierarchy of rank is considered undeniable.

Amongst the people of Krovmaer, only Elder Wyrms speak directly to the dragons. These leadership figures regularly are allowed audiences with the Dragons in order to seek guidance and instruction.

Most worship all the dragons and pray to one of the different 5 for various reasons. Why the gods haven't struck down such blasphemy has continued to be a point of contention among the faithful.
