

Past tenses

Past Simple

1. ****Completed actions in the past (Befejezett cselekvések a múltban)****

- They visited the museum yesterday. → Tegnap meglátogatták a múzeumot.

2. ****Repeated actions in the past (Ismétlődő cselekvések a múltban)****

- She often went to the gym when she lived in Paris. → Gyakran járt edzőterembe, amikor Párizsban élt.

3. ****A series of completed actions (Egy sorozat befejezett cselekvés)****

- He finished his work, cleaned the room, and went home. → Befejezte a munkáját, kitakarította a szobát, majd hazament.

Past Continuous

▶ FOLYAMATOS MÚLT IDŐ - PAST PROGRESSIVE - Angol Nyelvtan Egyszerűen

1. ****Actions in progress at a specific time in the past (Folyamatban lévő cselekvések a múlt egy adott időpontjában)****

- They were reading when the teacher entered the room. → Olvastak, amikor a tanár belépett a terembe.

2. ****Interrupted actions (Megszakított cselekvések)****

- I was cooking dinner when the phone rang. → Épp vacsorát főztem, amikor megcsörrent a telefon.

3. ****Actions that were in progress at the same time (Egyszerre zajló cselekvések)****

- She was listening to music while he was doing his homework. → Zenét hallgatott, miközben ő a házi feladatát csinálta.

4. ****Temporary actions in the past (Átmeneti cselekvések a múltban)****

- I was staying with my cousin for the summer. → A nyarat az unokatestvéremnél töltöttem.

Past Perfect Simple

▶ PAST PERFECT - ELŐIDEJŰSÉG, RÉGMÚLT - Angol Nyelvtan Egyszerűen

1. ****Actions that happened before another action in the past (Korábbi cselekvések, amelyek megelőztek egy másik múltbeli cselekvést)****

- By the time we arrived, they had already left. → Mire megérkeztünk, már elmentek.

2. ****Past actions that had an effect on a later action (Múltbeli cselekvések, amelyek hatással voltak egy későbbi cselekvésre)****

- She was sad because she had failed the test. → Szomorú volt, mert megbukott a vizsgán.

3. ****Experiences before a specific point in the past (Tapasztalatok egy adott múltbeli időpont előtt)****

- I had never seen such a beautiful sunset before that day. → Azelőtt a nap előtt soha nem láttam ilyen gyönyörű naplementét.

Past Perfect Continuous

1. ****Actions that were already ongoing before another past action (Olyan cselekvések, amelyek egy másik múltbeli cselekvés előtt már folyamatban voltak)****

- They had been waiting for hours when the train finally arrived. → Órák óta vártak, amikor a vonat végre megérkezett.

2. ****Emphasizing the duration of an action before another past action (Hangsúlyozza egy cselekvés időtartamát egy másik múltbeli cselekvés előtt)****

- She had been studying all night before the exam. → Egész éjjel tanult a vizsga előtt.

3. ****Actions that caused visible results in the past (Múltbeli cselekvések, amelyek látható eredményeket okoztak)****

- He was tired because he had been working hard all day. → Fáradt volt, mert egész nap keményen dolgozott.
