

AFS BY-LAW RESOLUTION 2 – AFS BY-LAW AMENDMENTS

WHEREAS the current wording of the AFS By-law resolutions is inconsistent with PIPSC by-laws;

AND WHEREAS the current wording demands that bylaw changes be included in the AGM notification;

AND WHEREAS the current wording makes by-law changes prohibitive;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that AFS by-laws for AFS by-law resolutions be changed as follows;

BYLAW 10 CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

10.1 These By-Laws may be amended at a General Meeting of the Group. Approval of proposed amendments requires a simple majority of those voting.

10.2 All proposals for amendments to these By-Laws shall be submitted, in writing, to the Group Executive **not later than eight (8) weeks prior to the General Meeting**. Proposed amendments may be submitted by any member of the Group. ~~The notice of the Group meeting at which the amendments will be considered, shall include:~~

10.3 Proposed amendments to these By-Laws will be provided to members no less than four (4) weeks prior to the General Meeting.

10.3 4 New Constitutions and By-Laws, as well as any amendments, shall be submitted to the Institute By-Laws and Policies Committee for review.

10.4 5 This Constitution and By-Laws and any amendments thereto shall take effect upon ratification by the Group membership and approval by the Institute.
