

# STARS Credit FAQs

**1. How do I get registered for STARS Credit?**

There is no formal registration process. Just enter your STARS Registry ID on the Participant Information Survey sent with your first session evaluation. For Project SCOPE, you will add your PTSB number during registration.

**2. How many credits can I receive?**

This is no limit to the number of STARS credits you could earn, except the limit given by the number of sessions available.

**3. How much is the credit fee?**

There is no cost - it's free!

**4. Can I receive STARS Credit for both semesters?**

Yes. UW ECHO reports credit to STARS in December for the fall semester and June for the spring semester.

**5. Can I earn STARS Credit for watching past session recordings?**

No. We are unable to award credit for viewing past session recordings.

**6. What are the requirements to earn credit?**

The requirements are as follows:

- Completion of the UW ECHO pre-test and indicate that you will be joining the Act Early, Assistive Technology, Autism & Positive Behavior Supports, and/or Project SCOPE network sessions.
- Attend the live sessions in the above networks AND complete the session evaluations that are emailed to you after each session.
- Completion of the UW ECHO post-test.

**7. When must all my credit requirements be completed?**

The pre-test will be included with the session evaluation for your first session attended. The deadline for attending sessions, submitting session evaluations, and completing the post-test is May 26th.
