## **Guide to Medical Documentation at UPEI**

Please note: to be eligible for the Canadian Services and Equipment Grant a student must be a student loan holder who qualifies for at least \$1 of a student loan. For more information please visit the <a href="Service Canada Website">Service Canada Website</a>.

Are you	Medical Documentation Required
A student with a Learning Disability in reading, writing, or math who is applying for the Canadian Services and Equipment Grant?	You will be required to submit a psycho-education report from a psychologist from either:  A. the last 5 years  B. over the age of 18 years
A student with a <b>Learning Disability in reading, writing, or math</b> who is <b>not</b> applying for the Canadian Services and Equipment Grant?	You will be required to submit a psycho-education report from a psychologist from either:  A. the last 5 years  B. over the age of 18 years
A student with a disability other than a Learning Disability (including ADHD) who is applying for the Canadian Services and Equipment Grant?	Your province will have a specific Medical Documentation Form for you to fill out to be eligible for the services and equipment grant.  For PEI residents: Medical Assessment Form  If you are not a PEI resident your province will have its own medical form you must fill out to be eligible for the grant. A student with a disability other than a Learning Disability (including ADHD) who is not eligible for the Canadian Services and Equipment Grant.	You will be required to submit the general medical documentation form.
